- 3 Jan** Give thanks for the freedom we have here in the UK to meet freely at the CPG tonight. Ask that we would be united in our vision to see Jesus' kingdom grow as we start a new year.
- 4 Jan** Give thanks for the hard work Steve and Paul do to serve our church family. Pray they would continue to hold firmly to God's word and continue to grow in godliness.
- 5 Jan** Give thanks for the wedding of Patrick MacGregor and Ally Suen today. Pray that their marriage would reflect and be centred on the sacrificial love Jesus has for his church.
- 6 Jan** Ask that as we come together as children of God to hear his words, we would be ready to repent and rejoice that our sins are forgiven.
