

# SENIOR SCHOOL FEES 2018-2019

Registration fee £100

Deposit £500 forfeited if place not taken

A pupil cannot be accepted into the School until the deposit has been paid. If the place is taken up, the deposit will be refunded to parents on their child's final account.

The number of optional lessons per term may vary depending on the length of the term.

School trips – as and when organised, with advance notice to parents, the cost of each is advised in advance.

**Notice period** – a term's notice (given before the final day of the preceding term) must be given in writing to the Head if: a pupil is being removed from the School; a pupil has a change of status e.g. from day to full or weekly boarding; or, there is any change to optional extras. **Failure to give notice will result in a term's fees in lieu being charged.** 

Bills are sent at the end of each term. Accounts must be settled in full by the first day of the next term; a 1.5% administration charge will be applied to any fee invoice not paid on time, in addition to interest at 2% on any outstanding balance. Details of paying by direct debit, under a separate contractual arrangement, are available on request from the Bursary.
