Lindsey Parish Council considers that the proposal to put Lindsey into the South East Cosford Ward did not make sense and could not be supported by the Council for the following reasons:

It cuts off all the benefice villages with the main benefice Church

Whilst Lindsey might be back with Kersey both had been included within a strange ward. Chelsworth, Kersey and Semer are understandable but the others have very little in common with Lindsey.

It was agreed that the following amendments to the proposals should be submitted – Monks Eleigh and Brent Eleigh moved out of Box Vale and into to SE Cosford; Kersey and Lindsey moved out of SE Cosford and into Box Vale. This would allow the catchment area to follow the electorate division. It was agreed that the names being proposed were better than those previously suggested.
