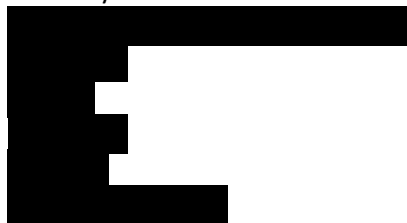

### **ELECTORAL REVIEW OF CARLISLE: WARDING ARRANGMENTS**

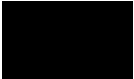
Hethersgill Parish Council met in March and carefully considered the review of the ward boundaries for Carlisle.
