### Comment text:

I welcome your proposals regarding Dedworth as these should make the area easier to administer and enable ward councillors to complete projects for specific parts of Dedworth Road. Retaining the parliamentary boundary in this area is also welcome. Your proposal to merge Old Windsor with the Boltons area to achieve equality of representation does not seem sensible to me. I do understand that areas to the south of the Royal Borough will be over represented under your proposal and that Old Windsor will be over represented if it is not supplemented with another area but combining it with the Boltons (a community that identifies itself with Windsor rather than old Windsor does not make sense). An exception should be made in this case by creating a ward consisting of Old Windsor and Great Park using the relevant parish council boundaries to the west. This ward would be over represented compared with the rest of RBWM but when compared with neighbouring wards in the south the variance should be acceptable. I would also argue for an extra councillor in Clewer east (to include the Boltons) as this would minimise the electoral variance within Windsor. Bringing the total number back to 43 (the Council's original proposal) would create a small additional variance across the borough but this would not detract from the overall impact of your proposals.
