Subject: RE: Have your say on new ward boundaries in Windsor and Maidenhead

Cox Green Parish Council would like express the view that the Borough Ward should continue to be coterminous with the civil parish boundary representing a defined community. Much of the current boundary uses the motorway classed roads the M4 and A404(M), both of which provide a physical separation from the neighbouring area. This has led to a distinct community of urban density which shares community, educational, commercial and recreational facilities within the parish. This distinctiveness reinforces the representational requirements of residents with its ward councillors within the Borough Council and should be maintained.

It is accepted that the number of Borough Councillors within the ward may change in order to provide overall equality of representation across the Borough insofar that the above considerations are adequately sustained.
