Comment text:

I am a former Deal Town councillor and I have concerns over the new wards proposed by DDC that cut across existing Parish and Town Council boundaries. Reductions in Deal and Walmer would be achieved by making North Deal, Middle Deal, Mill Hill and Walmer two member wards. This would keep to the parish boundaries and would not need the changes the cut across existing communities. Not only do residents identify with the existing wards but community groups are based in these communities, in the future they will suffer from dwindling members and from getting funds from these hybrid wards. I also have concerns about changing the Tower Hamlets ward in Dover, the community there is as distinct and important as the one where I live, Mill Hill in Deal, and both disappear in the DDC plans. Also, I object to the DDC proposals around Aylesham. I believe the existing ward should remain as the plans for the changes around the surrounding villages cut across parish boundaries and the resident numbers from new builds will support Aylesham staying as it is.
