### Comment text:

I acknowledge the need to have the boundaries moved as populations change. I have read the Commission's proposals I would like to focus my comments on Redhill. It is the place I live and work in. I am also a member of the Borough council representing residents in Redhill West. Two points I would make are: 1. The Commission's ward boundaries cut through communities; 2. Some of the name changes do not reflect the place nor the community. For example when I asked residents to geographically describe where 'Coles Meads and Wray Common' most struggled. Redhill is easily to define as East and West, using A23 as a boundary. The Borough council's response to the proposal is fair, balanced and well thought out. It carries the unanimous support of the council. The name of Redhill West and Wray Common accurately reflects the ward. With regard to communities it recognised that the Commission's suggestion was to split the community of the Cromwell estate into two and strongly placed the argument to keep all of the estate in Redhill West. I do hope the Commission will look favourably on the Council's response and adopt it's proposals.
