### Comment text:

In my opinion the working group on Boundary Review at Reigate and Banstead Borough Council have spent considerable time and effort drawing up a sensible format for the new boundaries, which take into account the local wishes of the people who live in the borough and the roads which will be affected. Local people who feel part of a community in one area should not suddenly find it has been divided into two different wards. Consequently, if looked at geographically on the ground (rather than just on a map) the suggestions the Council has made for Woodmansterne will keep that community together rather than ripping it apart. In addition, as the residential developments in the areas of Park Farm and the Queen Elizabeth Hospital land can only access through Park Road and are near Banstead Woods it makes sense that these should be in the Banstead Village Ward. It is also obvious that St Margaret's Church should remain in the Chipstead Ward as it has been in Chipstead since it was built in the 12th and 13th Century! The Council have strongly supported the suggestions that Croydon Lane, Park Road and Woodmansterne Lane are incorporated in Banstead Village and I agree with this, including that there is a clear division along the two sides of the A217.
