**Subject:** Chew Magna Parish Council Comment

**Proposed ward combination with dual Ward Councillor allocation.**

Chew Magna Parish Council does not support the proposals to combine the wards of Chew Valley North and Chew Valley South to create a single ward of Chew Valley to be served jointly by two Ward Councillors.

We propose that the two wards are maintained with one Ward Councillor per ward, but with the addition of Stanton Drew to Chew Valley North's existing parishes of Chew Magna, Chew Stoke and Norton Malreward.

We feel that this would be more manageable and would make sense geographically as the current parishes are close neighbours. Furthermore, the addition of Stanton Drew to Chew Valley North would balance the Wards with four parishes each.
