According to electoral data published by WDC18, Leamington Manor ward currently (2017) has a voter to councillor ratio of 2,609, compared to the average across the District of 2,373. This puts it at the top limit of 10% above the average. However, the same data shows that expected population increases across the district by the time of the next but one district elections (2023) will have increased the district average to 2,681 voters per councillor, whereas the same extrapolation predicts no increase in the size of the electorate of Leamington Manor ward. This means that although the ward ratio would remain unchanged at 2,609, it will fall to -3% when compared with the average for the District. On the basis that the boundaries proposal is to ensure reasonable equality of voter/councillor ratios, I recommend leaving Leamington Manor Ward boundaries as they currently exist.
