The Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1999

Made..... 17th December 1999*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to recommendations made to him for the alteration of the area of parishes within the district of Cherwell and for the constitution of a new parish within that district.

Citation and commencement

1.- (1) This Order may be cited as the Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1999.

(2) It shall come into force –

(a) for the purposes of this article, articles 2 and 3 and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections for parish councillors to be held on 4th May 2000, on the day after that on which it is made;

(b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2000.

(3) In this Order –

“the Council” means the Cherwell District Council;

“the new parish” means the parish of Banbury constituted by article 2;

“the map” means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions, marked “Map of the Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1999” and deposited in accordance with regulation 6 of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b); and

any reference to a numbered sheet is a reference to the sheet of the map bearing that number.

Constitution of the new parish and consequential provision

2.- (1) A new parish, comprising the area delineated by a blue line on sheet 5 of the map, shall be constituted within the district of Cherwell.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Banbury.

(3) In consequence of paragraph (1) –

- (i) the areas marked “B” and “B1” on sheet 1 of the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Drayton and the district ward of Wroxton; area “B” shall become part of the district ward of Hardwick, and area “B1” shall become part of the district ward of Ruscote;
- (ii) the area marked “D” on sheet 1 of the map shall cease to be part of the parish of Hanwell and the district ward of Hornton, and shall become part of the district ward of Hardwick.

Direction to establish parish council

3. - (1) The Council is hereby directed to establish a parish council for the new parish.

(2) 1st April 2000 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(a).

Consequential and transitional provision

4. Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish at the election to be held on 4th May 2000 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by those persons who, immediately before the coming into force of this Order, are the elected councillors for the district wards which comprise the area of the new parish.

Alteration of other parish areas and district wards

5.- (1) Each area shaded in blue and designated by a letter on sheets 1 to 4 of the map and specified in column (1) of the Schedule –

- (a) shall cease to be part of the parish (if any) specified in relation to that area in column (2) and shall become part of the parish so specified in column (3); and

(a) S.I. 1999/545.

(b) shall cease to be part of the district ward (if any) so specified in column (4) and shall become part of the district ward so specified in column (5).

(2) The boundary of the area of the parish of Ambrosden shall follow the centre of the stream marked A to B on sheet 2 of the map.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order creates a new parish for Banbury in the district of Cherwell, transfers areas between parishes and, in some cases, makes consequential changes to district wards. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the areas concerned.

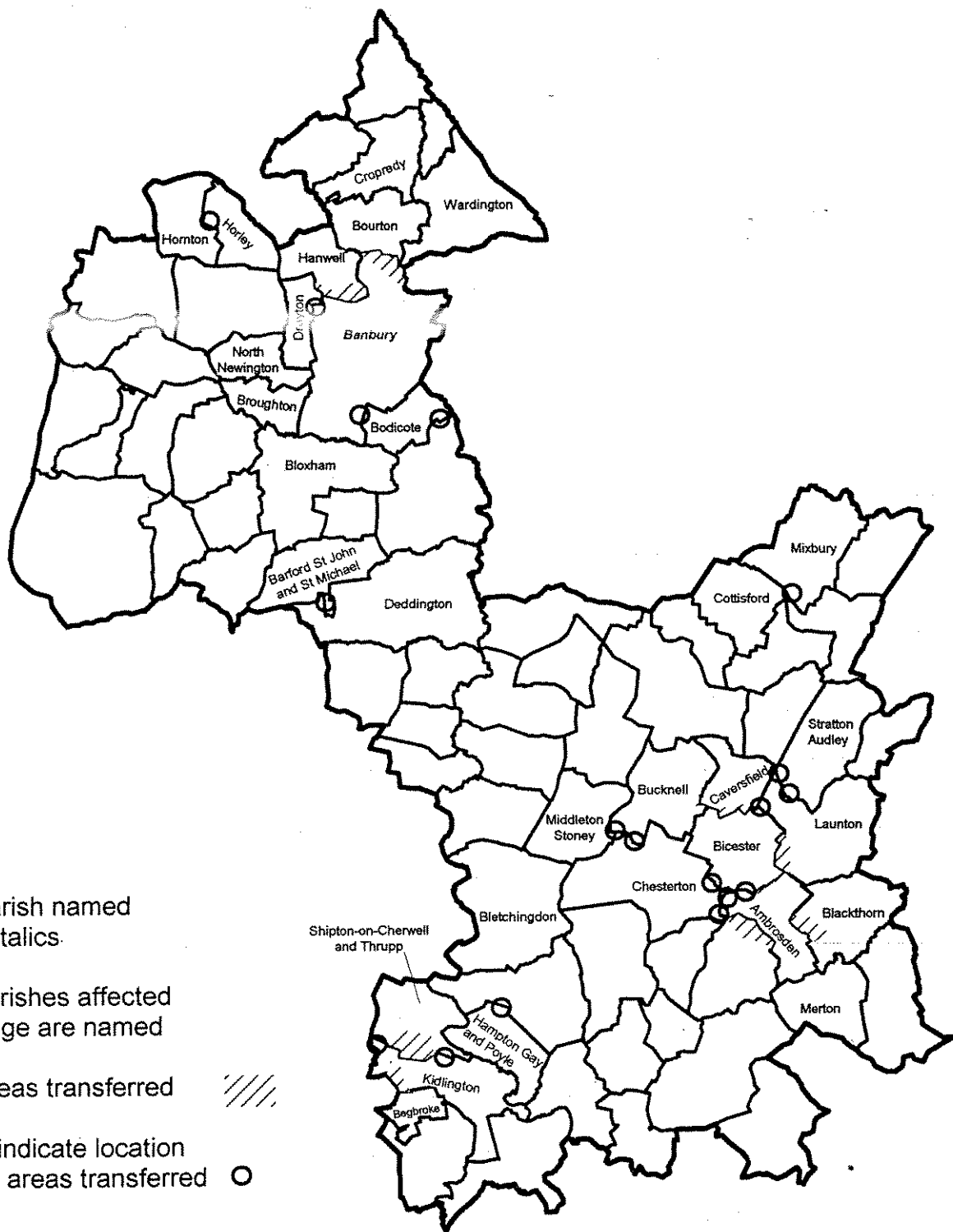
Articles 2 creates the new parish of Banbury.

Article 3 directs the Cherwell District Council to establish a parish council for the new parish. 1st April 2000 is specified as the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make provision of general application in relation to orders such as this Order.

Article 4 provides for the parish of Banbury to be represented by the district councillors elected for the district wards which cover the area of the parish until councillors for the parish of Banbury, elected at the election to be held on 4th May 2000, come into office.

Article 5 makes alterations to the areas of parishes. On 1st April 2000 each area specified in column (1) of the Schedule to the Order will cease to be part of the parish (if any) and district ward specified in columns (2) and (4), and will become part of the parish and district ward specified in columns (3) and (5). If, in relation to an area specified in column (1), no district ward is specified in column (4), the area will continue to be part of the district ward in which it currently lies.
