BULLETIN OF CHANGES OF LOCAL AUTHORITY STATUS, NAMES AND AREAS

1 APRIL 1992 - 31 MARCH 1993

PART A

Orders made by the Secretary of State for the Environment under Part IV of the Local Government Act 1972.

1. There are 4 Orders creating new parishes or altering the boundaries of existing ones.
2. There are 40 Orders altering the boundaries of counties or districts with associated parish changes.

PART B

Changes effected by Royal Charter, or by local authority action or order.

3. Grant of borough status - Section 245 of The Local Government Act 1972 - 3 cases.
4. Change of name of county, district or London borough under Section 74 of The Local Government Act 1972 - 1 case.
5. Change of name of parish under section 75 of The Local Government Act 1972 - none in the period.

PART A

ORDERS MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT UNDER
PART IV OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972

The following Orders alter the boundaries of counties and/or districts and London boroughs and/or parishes. A few additionally abolish or create parishes. Some of the Orders came into effect on 1 April 1993. Others, although made in this period, will not be effective until 1 April 1994. The effective date of each Order is given at the end of the entry.

Avon

The Northavon (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 300)
Only one alteration (to transfer a school from the parish of Bradley Stoke to the parish of Patchway) is made in this Order. It is effective from 1 April 1993.

The Woodspring (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 443)
This Order abolishes the parishes of North Weston and Portishead and creates a new parish from the areas of those parishes and parts of the parish of Portbury. Other parishes are affected by boundary changes. The Order is effective from 1 April 1993.

Cambridgeshire

The Cambridgeshire and Suffolk (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 3026)
This Order makes minor changes along the county boundary in the vicinity of Newmarket. The effective date is 1 April 1993.

Cheshire

The Cheshire, Derbyshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 493)
The description of this Order is under the entry for Greater

Manchester.

The Cheshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2026)

The description of this Order is under the entry for Greater Manchester.

The Cheshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) (No. 2) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2091)

The Cheshire, Greater Manchester, Lancashire and Merseyside (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 436)

The Cheshire, Lancashire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI No. 1993 No. 378)

The Cheshire, Lancashire and Merseyside (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 691)

The Cheshire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 1992)

The Cheshire and Merseyside (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 394)

The description of this Order is under the entry for Merseyside.

Derbyshire

The Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2092)

There are a series of small amendments along this county boundary, affecting the districts of Amber Valley, Bolsover, and Erewash in Derbyshire and Ashfield, Bassetlaw, Broxtowe and Mansfield in Nottinghamshire. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Derbyshire and Nottinghamshire (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 444)

This Order transfers three small areas from Nottinghamshire, the district of Bassetlaw and the parish of Nether Langwith to Derbyshire, the district of Bolsover and the parish of Scarcliffe. In total the areas consist of less than one hectare and only 13 people are affected by the changes. They are effective from 1 April 1994.

The Derbyshire, Nottinghamshire and South Yorkshire (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 729)

The description of this Order is under the entry for South Yorkshire.

The Derbyshire and South Yorkshire (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 393)

The description of this Order is under the entry for South Yorkshire.

Durham

The Durham, Northumberland and Tyne and Wear (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 3050)

The description of this Order is under the entry for Tyne & Wear.

The Durham and Tyne and Wear (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 3054)

The description of this Order is under the entry for Tyne and Wear.

East Sussex

The East Sussex, West Sussex and Kent (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2096)

The local government areas affected by the changes in this Order are Brighton, Hove, Lewes, Rother and Wealden in East Sussex, and Tunbridge Wells in Kent and Adur and Mid Sussex in West Sussex. Most of the changes are minor amendments. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Wealden (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 299)

Only one area is affected by this Order. It is transferred from the parish of Hellingly to the parish of Hailsham. The Order is effective from 1 April 1993.

Essex

The Essex, Greater London and Hertfordshire (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 441)

The description for this Order is under the entry for Greater London.

The Essex and Hertfordshire (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2119)

Many adjustments are made to this county boundary involving 170 hectares transferring from Essex to Hertfordshire (and affecting a population of 500) and 260 hectares transferring from Hertfordshire to Essex (with a population transfer of 60). The principal local authorities are Broxbourne and East Hertfordshire in Hertfordshire and Epping Forest, Harlow and Uttlesford in Essex. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

Greater London

The Essex, Greater London and Hertfordshire (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 441)

This Order makes amendments on London Borough of Enfield's boundaries with the London Borough of Barnet, Hertsmere, Welwyn Hatfield and Broxbourne in Hertfordshire and Epping Forest in

Essex. The largest area changes are between Enfield and Hertfordshire where the boundary realignment to the M25 transfers over 300 hectares. About 350 people are affected by the boundary changes between Enfield and Barnet. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater London and Hertfordshire (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (1992 No. 1696)

This Order affects the boundaries of Barnet and Harrow in Greater London and Hertsmere in Hertfordshire. It unites the community of Elstree in Hertsmere and makes adjustments to the open areas around the A1 and A1081. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Greater London and Hertfordshire (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2088)

This Order makes changes to the borough of Harrow and its boundaries with Hertsmere in Hertfordshire and Ealing and Hillingdon, both in Greater London. Most are small changes, although the one to Hertsmere from Harrow involves 285 people. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Greater London and Kent (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2090)

This Order affects the county boundary between Greater London (Bexley) and Kent (Dartford). Only minor changes are made. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Greater London and Kent (County Boundaries) (Variation) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 805)

This Order varies the supplementary provisions in the Greater London and Kent (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2090) to include consequential changes to the Metropolitan Police District. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Greater London, Kent and Surrey (County Boundaries) Order

1993 (SI 1993 No. 400)

Changes are made to the London Boroughs of Bexley and Bromley's boundaries with Sevenoaks in Kent and to Bromley's boundary with Tandridge in Surrey. The biggest changes are made in the parish of Crockenhill in Sevenoaks. The effective date of this date is 1 April 1994.

Greater Manchester

The Bolton and Salford (City and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 851)

Small changes are made between Bolton and Salford in the vicinity of the Clifton housing estate. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Cheshire, Derbyshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 493)

The boundaries of the Borough of Stockport with the Borough of Tameside in Greater Manchester, High Peak in Derbyshire and Macclesfield in Cheshire are affected by this Order. The parishes involved are New Mills in High Peak and Prestbury, Adlington, Poynton with Worth, Lyme Handley and Disley in Macclesfield. Most of the changes are small. In total they affect about 130 hectares and 50 people. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Cheshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2026)

This Order affects the metropolitan borough of Tameside and its boundaries with Warrington and Macclesfield in Cheshire and with the City of Manchester in Greater Manchester. The greatest change is at Brooklands where a population of over 1,200 is transferred to Trafford. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Cheshire and Greater Manchester (County and District Boundaries) (No. 2) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2091)

A number of amendments are made to the City of Manchester's boundaries with Salford, Stockport and Tameside in Greater Manchester and with Macclesfield in Cheshire. Although not large in area, there are population changes of 400 between Manchester and Salford and 2,240 between Manchester and Stockport. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Cheshire, Greater Manchester, Lancashire and Merseyside (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 436)
This Order covers changes to Wigan's boundaries with Bolton and Salford (within Greater Manchester), Warrington in Cheshire, Chorley and West Lancashire in Lancashire and St Helens in Merseyside. The biggest are from Wigan to Warrington in Cheshire (at Culcheth and Croft - 570 hectares and 370 people) and from Wigan to Salford (at Boothstown - about 90 hectares and over 2440 people) and from Wigan to St Helens (400 hectares and 470 people). The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater Manchester and Lancashire (County and District Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 926)
Small changes are made to the boundaries between the Greater Manchester boroughs of Bury, Salford and Manchester and between Bury and the Lancashire boroughs of Blackburn and Rossendale. Although only about 24 hectares are affected, there is a large population change between the City of Manchester and Bury at Heaton Park (about 450 people). The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater Manchester and Lancashire (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 902)
This Order slightly changes the boundary between Rochdale in Greater Manchester and Rossendale in Lancashire and within Greater Manchester between Rochdale and Bury. Only about 2 hectares and 42 people are affected. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater Manchester and West Yorkshire (County and District

Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 2120)

Boundary adjustments are made between the Greater Manchester metropolitan boroughs of Oldham, Rochdale, the City of Manchester and Tameside and between Oldham and Kirklees in West Yorkshire. There is only one large change, 150 hectares that transfers from Rochdale to Oldham. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

Hereford & Worcester

The Bromsgrove (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 442)

Five new parishes (Barnt Green, Bournheath, Catshill, Finstall and Lickey) are created by this Order. In addition boundary changes are made to several of the existing parishes. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Hereford and Worcester, Staffordshire and West Midlands (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 492)

The description of this Order is under the entry for West Midlands.

The Hereford and Worcester and Warwickshire (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 272)

This Order makes changes in the boundary between the counties of Hereford and Worcester and Warwickshire, affecting the districts of Bromsgrove, Redditch and Wychavon and Stratford-on-Avon. The main changes occur in the Beoley and Pebworth areas. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Hereford and Worcester, Warwickshire and West Midlands (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 437)

The description of this Order is under the entry for West Midlands.

Humberside

The Humberside and South Yorkshire (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 168)

The boundary changes effected by this Order are between Boothferry and Doncaster. Few people are affected but about 1270 hectares are transferred, principally between the parishes of Crowle (in Boothferry) and Thorne (in Doncaster). The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

Merseyside

The Cheshire, Lancashire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI No. 1993 No. 378)

The boundaries of St Helens in Merseyside with Halton and Warrington in Cheshire and West Lancashire in Lancashire are affected by this Order. Most of the changes occur between St Helens and Halton where 260 hectares and 120 people are affected. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Cheshire, Lancashire and Merseyside (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 691)

This Order makes changes to the boundaries of Merseyside borough of Knowsley with the City of Liverpool, St Helens and Sefton (also in Merseyside) and with the Borough of Halton in Cheshire and West Lancashire in Lancashire. Some of the changes are large, the biggest being the transfer of 830 hectares from Knowsley to West Lancashire which also involves the creation of a new parish of Simonswood. The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1994.

The Cheshire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992 No. 1992)

This Order makes changes in the boundary between the borough of Ellesmere Port and Neston (in Cheshire) and the metropolitan borough of Wirral (in Merseyside). The effective date of this Order is 1 April 1993.

The Cheshire and Merseyside (County and Metropolitan Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993 No. 394)
