The West Oxfordshire (Parishes) Order 2000

Made - - - -

3rd May 2000

Coming into force

1st April 2001

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order which gives effect to recommendations made to him by West Oxfordshire District Council for the alteration of the area of parishes within the district of West Oxfordshire and for changes in electoral arrangements:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the West Oxfordshire (Parishes) Order 2000.

(2) It shall come into force on 1st April 2001.

(3) In this Order "the map" means the map prepared by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions, marked "Map of the West Oxfordshire (Parishes) Order 2000" and deposited in accordance with regulation 6 of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b).

Alteration of parish areas and district wards

2. Each area shaded in blue and designated by a letter on the map and specified in column (1) of the Schedule -

(a) shall cease to be part of the parish specified in relation to that area in column (2) and shall become part of the parish so specified in column (3); and

- (b) shall cease to be part of the district ward (if any) so specified in column (4) and shall become part of the district ward so specified in column (5).

Electoral arrangements in the parishes of Curbridge and Witney

3. - (1) The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Curbridge shall be five.

(2) The number of councillors to be elected for the parish of Witney shall be sixteen.

(3) The number of councillors to be elected for each of the Witney South and Witney West wards shall be five; for the Witney East ward shall be four and for the Witney North ward shall be two.

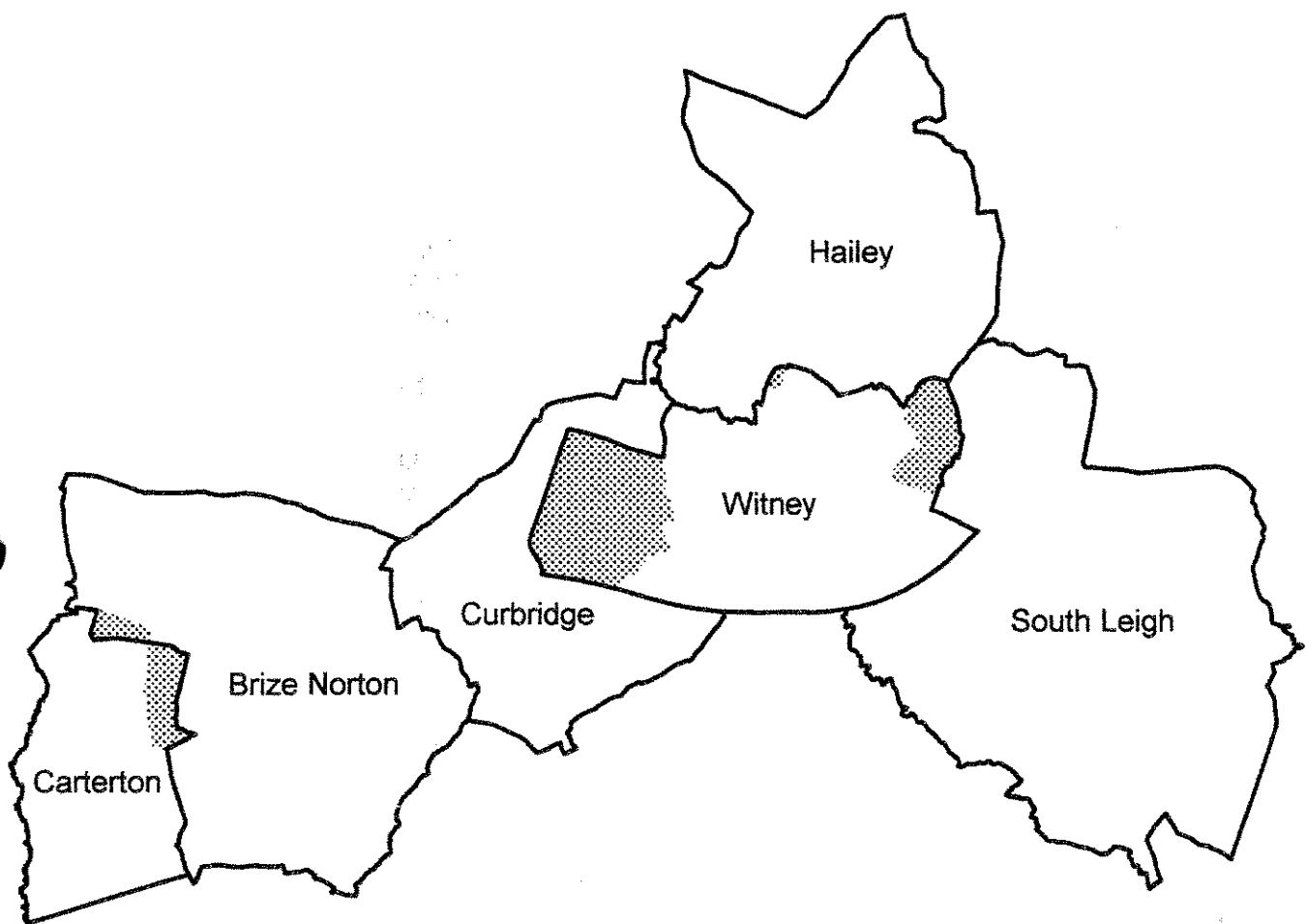
EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order transfers areas between parishes and, in some cases, makes consequential changes to district wards, and makes some changes to electoral arrangements for parishes, in the district of West Oxfordshire. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the areas concerned.

Article 2 makes alterations to the areas of parishes. On 1st April 2001 each area specified in column (1) of the Schedule to the Order will cease to be part of the parish and district ward specified in columns (2) and (4), and will become part of the parish and district ward specified in columns (3) and (5). If, in relation to an area specified in column (1), no district ward is specified in column (4), the area will continue to be part of the district ward in which it currently lies.

Article 3 makes changes, from 1st April 2001, in the electoral arrangements of the parishes of Curbridge and Witney.
