

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN
HEALTH ACT 2007

The Vale of White Horse District Council
(Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010

Made 30 September 2010

Coming into force in accordance with articles 1(2), 1(3) and 1(4)

The Vale of White Horse District Council (“the council”), in accordance with section 9 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997⁽¹⁾ (“the 1997 Act”) and Part 4 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007⁽²⁾ (“the 2007 Act”) as applied by paragraphs 4(7) and 6(3) of the schedule to the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (Commencement Number 3, Transitional and Saving Provisions and Commencement No 2 (Amendment)) Order 2008⁽³⁾ (the 2008 Order), has undertaken a review and made recommendations dated October 2005 and February 2006;

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 10(1) and 10(2) of the 1997 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons;

The council, in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9(5) of the 1997 Act (as amended by the 2008 Order) and sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Vale of White Horse District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010.

(2) Subject to articles 1(3) and 1(4) below, this Order comes into force on 1st April 2011.

(3) For the purposes of:

(a) this article,

(b) Schedule 1, and

(c) proceedings preliminary or relating to the election of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011 in respect of the parishes set out in sub-paragraph (d) below, this Order shall come into force on 1st October 2010.

(d) The parishes referred to in sub-paragraph (c) above are the parishes set out in the first column of Schedule 1 to this Order in respect of the parish wards, if any, set out in the second column of Schedule

1 to this Order, being the parishes and parish wards affected by the changes made by this Order.

(4) For the purposes of:

(a) this article, and

(b) (i) proceedings preliminary or relating to the calculation and issue of precepts by parish councils affected by changes made by this Order pursuant to Chapter 4 of the 1992 Act and (ii) proceedings preliminary or relating to the obligations of the Council pursuant to Chapter 4 of the 1992 Act, this Order shall come into force on 1st October 2010.

Interpretation

2. In this Order-

“district” means the district of the Vale of White Horse

“existing” means existing on the date this Order is made;

“map” means one of the maps numbered 1 to 10 and marked “Map no [] referred to in the Vale of White Horse District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2010” and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act: and any reference to a numbered map is a reference to a map which bears that number;

“ordinary day of election of councillors” has the meaning given by section 37 of the Representation of the People Act 1983;

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8⁽⁴⁾ of the Representation of the People Act 1983;

“the 1992 Act” means the Local Government Finance Act 1992; and

“the 2001 Order” means the District of Vale of White Horse (Electoral Changes) Order 2001 SI 2001 No. 4064.

Effect of Order

3. This Order amends the 2001 Order and has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to any provision of this Order.

Parish wards of the District of Vale of White Horse

4. (1) The parish wards of the District of Vale of White Horse are amended in accordance with articles 5 to 11 of this Order; and
 - (2) Maps highlighting existing areas to be changed by paragraphs 5 to 11 of this Order are set out in Schedule 1.
 - (3) Maps highlighting new boundaries after the changes made by paragraphs 5 to 11 of this Order are set out in Schedule 2.

Alteration of parish areas and of the areas of parish wards

Wards of the parishes of East Challow and Wantage

5. (1) The South East ward in the parish of East Challow (as hatched green on Map 1 and marked "SE") shall be added to the ward of Segsbury in the parish of Wantage;

(2) subsequent to the changes set out in sub-paragraph (1) above, the remaining North ward of the parish of East Challow (as hatched red on Map 1 and marked "North") shall be abolished and, therefore, the parish of East Challow shall be unwarded; and

(3) subsequent to the changes set out in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, the existing number of councillors elected to the parishes of East Challow and Wantage (being seven and six respectively) shall not change.

Wards of the parishes of Grove and Wantage

6. (1) The ward of Mably in the parish of Grove (as hatched brown on Map 1 and marked "Mably") shall be added to the ward of Segsbury in the parish of Wantage;

(2) subsequent to the change set out in sub-paragraph (1) above, the remaining North ward in the parish of Grove (as hatched purple on Map 1 and marked “NG”) shall be abolished and, therefore, the parish of Grove shall be unwarded; and

(3) subsequent to the changes set out in sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, the existing number of councillors elected to the parish of Grove and the ward of Segsbury (being sixteen and six respectively) shall not change.

Wards of the parishes of Longworth and Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor

7. (1) The South ward in the parish of Longworth (as hatched blue on Map 2 and marked “South”) shall be added to the parish of Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor (the parish of Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor being an existing unwarded parish);

(2) subsequent to the changes set out in sub-paragraph (1) above, the existing number of councillors elected to the parishes of Longworth and Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor (being seven and nine respectively) shall not change; and

(3) The North ward in the parish of Longworth (as hatched red on Map 2 and marked “North”) shall be known as West ward and the number of councillors representing that ward shall not change.

Wards of the parishes of Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor and Longworth

8. (1) So much of the existing unwarded parish of Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor as is hatched purple on Map 2 shall be added to the existing warded parish of Longworth and shall be a new parish ward known as "East"; and

(2) subsequent to the changes made by sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, the number of councillors representing the parish of Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor (being nine) shall not change and the number of councillors representing the new East ward in the parish of Longworth shall be three.

Wards of the parishes of Milton and East Hendred

9. (1) So much of the existing Heights ward in the parish of Milton as is hatched green on Map 3 shall be added to the existing unwarded parish of East Hendred; and

(2) subsequent to the changes made by sub-paragraph (1) above, the number of councillors representing the Heights ward in the parish of Milton (being four) and the number of councillors representing the unwarded parish of East Hendred (being nine) shall not change.

Wards of the parishes of Wootton and St Helen Without

10. (1) So much of the existing unwarded parish of Wootton as is hatched green on Map 4 shall be added to the existing ward of Shippon in the parish of St. Helen Without; and

(2) subsequent to the changes made by sub-paragraph (1) above, the number of councillors representing the parish of Wootton (being twelve) and the number of councillors representing the parish ward of Shippon in the parish of St. Helen Without (being five) shall not change.

Wards of the parishes of Kennington and South Hinksey

11. (1) So much of the existing North ward of the parish of Kennington as is hatched green on Map 5 shall be added to the existing unwarded parish of South Hinksey;

(2) so much of the existing unwarded parish of South Hinksey as is hatched red on Map 5 shall be added to the parish of Kennington; and

(3) the parish of Kennington shall cease to be warded;

(4) subsequent to the changes made by sub-paragraphs (1) and (2) above, the number of councillors representing the parishes of Kennington and South Hinksey (being fourteen and five respectively) shall not change.

Electoral register

12. The registration officer for the district shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Transitional provisions

15. Parish councillors representing the existing wards or the existing parishes (as appropriate) set out in articles 5 to 11 of this Order immediately before the date of this order shall continue in office as if this Order had not been made until the elections to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2011 and the election on that date shall be election for the parishes or wards as amended by the said articles 5 to 11.

Order date

16. 1st April 2011 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) (England) Regulations 2008.

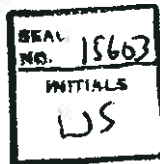
