## Part A

### Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State

1. Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State under section 37A of the representation of the Peoples Act 1983

There is one Order made by the Secretary of State, which made changes to the timing of local council elections.

#### **The Local Elections (Ordinary Day of Elections in 2014) Order 2013 No.2277**

This Order changes the date of local elections in England in 2014, so that it is the same date of the European Parliamentary elections in that year, and deals with a number of incidental, supplementary and consequential matters. The Order was made on 6 September 2013.

2. Changes effected by regulations of the Secretary of State under sections 10,11,12,13 and 15 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

There are two Orders made by the Secretary of State, which made changes to the boundary between two district councils.

#### **The East Hertfordshire and Stevenage (Boundary Change) Order 2013 No.596**

This Order made a change to the boundary between the district of East Hertfordshire and the Borough of Stevenage and consequential changes to corresponding parish boundaries. The Order was made on 12 March 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

#### **The Gateshead and Northumberland (Boundary Change) Order 2013 No.595**

This Order made a change to the boundary between the Borough of Gateshead and the County of Northumberland and consequential changes to corresponding parish boundaries. The Order was made on 12 March 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

3. Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State under section 86 (A1), (4) (7), 87 (1), (3) and 105 of the Local Government Act 2000.

There is one Order made by the Secretary of State, which made changes to electoral scheme in Doncaster.

#### **The Borough of Doncaster (Scheme of Elections) Order 2013 No. 2969**

This Order made a change to the scheme for holding elections of councillors from elections in thirds to whole council elections. The year of election for parish councillors has also changed.

## Part B

Changes effected by local authorities' action or Order as notified to the Secretary of State and the Local Government Boundary Commission for England

1. There are fourteen Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to amending electoral arrangements under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

### **The City of Oxford (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Blackbird Leys) Order 2012**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parish of Blackbird Leys to be 14. The Order was made on 1 August 2012 and came into effect on the same day.

### **The Durham County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parish of Edmondsley to be 7. The Order was made on 9 January 2013 and came into effect on 2 May 2013.

### **The Durham County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013 (2)**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parish of Trimdon to be 13. The Order was made on 5 March 2013 and came into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013.

### **The High Peak Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance Wormhill and Green Fairfield Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order dissolved the parish of Green Fairfield and grouped the parishes of Wormhill and Green Fairfield. The parish council will be known as Wormhill and Green Fairfield. The Order was made on 6 February 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

### **The Leeds (Community Governance Reorganisation) (Scarcroft Parish Council) Order 2012**

This Order provides for the number of parish of Scarcroft to be nine. The Order was made on 10 October 2012 and came into effect in 15 October 2012.

### **The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Newbiggin by the Sea) Order 2013**

The Order abolished the existing wards of the parish Newbiggin by the Sea and provides for four new parish wards and eight councillors. The Order was made on the 15 January 2013 and came into effect on 2 May 2013.

**The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Prudhoe) Order 2012**

The Order abolished the existing wards of the parish of Prudhoe and provides for six new parish wards and 15 parish councillors. The Order was made on 14 December 2012 and shall come into effect on 2 May 2013.

**The Winchester City (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bramdean and Hinton Ampner Parish) Order 2013**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parishes of Hinton Ampner and Bramdean to be 7. The Order was made on 15 February 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

**The Winchester City (Reorganisation of Community Governance in Wonston Parish) Order 2013**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parish of Wonston to increase from 7 to 8. The Order was made on 15 February 2013.

**The District of Shepway (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Town of Hawkinge) Order 2013**

This Order provides for the town of Hawkinge to be divided into 3 wards and 13 parish councillors. The Order was made on the 25 March 2013 and shall come into effect on the ordinary of elections of councillors in 2015.

**The South Cambridgeshire District Council (Enlargement of Parish Council) Order 2013 relating to parish of Hauxton**

This Order provides for the number of parish councillors in the parish of Hauxton to be 9. The Order was made on the 1 May 2013 and shall come into effect on the 5 May 2016.

**The Wychavon District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order reduces the number of councillors in the parishes of: Flyford Flavell, Grafton Flyford and North Piddle from 10 to 8 (4 in Flyford Flavell Parish Ward, 2 in Grafton Flyford Parish Ward and 2 in North Piddle Parish Ward). The Order was made on the 1 November 2013 and shall come into effect on the ordinary day of elections of councillors in 2015.

### **Eastleigh Borough Council (parish of West End) (Warding arrangements) Order 2013**

The Order provides for the number of wards in the parish of West End to be increased from 3 to 7. The Order was made on the 30 December 2013 and shall come into effect on the ordinary day of elections of councillors in 2015.

### **Cornwall Council Community Governance Reorganisation Order (Mevagissey Parish Council) Order 2013**

The Order reduces the number of councillors in Mevagissey Parish Council by two – from sixteen to fourteen councillors. The Order came into effect on 2 May 2013.

2. There is one Order, made by local authorities, which groups parish councils under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

### **The North Devon (Reorganisation of Community Governance) No.1 Order 2012**

This Order revokes the 1976 Order, grouping the Parishes of Brendon and Countisbury. The parishes of Brendon and Countisbury will cease to be single parishes and will become a single unwarded parish. The number of parish councillors representing Brendon and Countisbury will be 7. The number of parish councillors representing Goodleigh Parish Council will be increased by 2 from 5 to 7. The Order was made on 26 October 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

3. There are twenty one Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to changes to boundaries and electoral arrangements of parishes under the local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

### **The Chichester District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Fernhurst and Linchmere Order 2012**

This Order made changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Fernhurst and Linchmere. The Order was made on 5 April 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

### **The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parishes of Craster and Embleton) Order 2012**

This Order made changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Craster and Embleton. The Order was made on 14 December 2012 and came into effect on 15 December 2012.

### **The Shropshire (Reorganisation of Community Governance (Oswestry) Order 2012**

This Order made changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Oswestry, Oswestry Rural and Whittington. The Order also made changes to the electoral arrangements of the parish of Oswestry. The Order was made on 15 May 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**Hinckley and Bosworth Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance Order 2013**

This Order makes changes to the boundaries of the parish of Market Bosworth, renames the wards of the parish of Barwell and amends the number of councillors per ward in the parish of Shackerstone. The Order was made 28 March 2013 and will come into effect on the 1 April 2015.

**The Three Rivers District (Reorganisation of Community Governance Order 2013**

This Order makes changes to the boundaries of the parish Croxley Green. The Order was made on the 1 August 2013 and came in to effect on the 1 September 2013.

**Mid Sussex District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Hassocks) Order 2013**

This Order makes changes to the electoral wards of the parish of Hassocks. The Order was made on the 1 August 2013 and shall come into effect on the 1 April 2015.

**Mid Sussex District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Burgess Hill) Order 2013**

This Order makes changes to the electoral wards of the parish of Burgess Hill. The Order was made on the 1 August 2013 and shall come into effect on the 1 April 2015.

**Mid Sussex District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (East Grinstead) Order 2013**

This Order makes changes to the electoral wards of the parish of East Grinstead and designated the number of councillors for each parish ward. This Order was made on the 1 August 2013 and shall come into effect on the 1 April 2015.

**The Rugby Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance Order 2013**

This Order abolishes the parish meeting of Little Lawford and makes changes to the boundaries of the parish of Long Lawford. The Order was made on 1 December 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

**The Shropshire Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Ruyton XI Towns) Order 2012**

This Order makes changes to the boundaries to the parish of Ruyton XI Towns. The Order was made on 9 August 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**The Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order abolishes the parish council of Tarbock. The Order was made on 23 December 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2014.

The electoral changes came into effect in respect of local government elections to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013.

**The East Hampshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2012**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by East Hampshire District Council for the new parish of Sheet to be created and the alteration of the area of the parish of Petersfield. The parish of Sheet will be created with effect from 1 October 2012. Elections were held for the parish of Sheet in 2012, following which the electoral changes came into effect in respect of local government elections to be held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2014.

**The Chichester District Council (Reorganisation of community governance) Chidham, Hambrook and Southbourne Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made of Chichester District Council for the alternation of areas of the parishes of Chidham & Hambrook; and Southbourne within the district of Chichester. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Broadland District Council (Reorganisation of community governance) (Crosthewick/Spixworth) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Broadland District Council for a realignment of the parish boundary between the parishes of Crosthewick and Spixworth and the transfer of land from the parish of Crosthewick to the parish of Spixworth in the District of Broadland. The electoral arrangements came into effect following elections held on 1 June 2013.

**The Borough of Colchester (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2012**

The Order gives effect to recommendations made by Colchester Borough Council for the enlargement of the area covered by Myland Community Council. The Order was made on 26 November 2012.

### **The Tonbridge and Malling Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order alters the boundaries between the parish council of Ryarsh and the parish council of Leybourne. The number of councillors for the parish of Leybourne will be 11. The Order was made on 12 November 2013 and shall come into force on 1 April 2015. The number of councillors for Leybourne parish council shall come into force on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The Stratford-on-Avon (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Stratford-on-Avon District Council for ordinary elections of parish councils to be altered to fit within the new scheme of district elections, the alteration of the area of parishes of Alcester, Beaudesert, Binton, Coughton, Exhall, Haselor, Henley-in-Arden, Sambourne, Stratford-upon-Avon, Ullenhall, Welford-upon-Avon and Wootton Wawen, the abolition of the parish of Old Stratford and Drayton, the dissolution of the council for the parish of Old Stratford and Drayton within the District of Stratford-on-Avon.

The parish of Old Stratford and Drayton will be abolished with effect from 31 March 2015.

The parishes of Alcester, Beaudesert, Binton, Coughton, Exhall, Haselor, Henley-in-Arden, Sambourne, Stratford-upon-Avon, Ullenhall, Welford-on-Avon and Wootton Wawen will be altered with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The Cherwell District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cherwell District Council for the alteration of the areas of the parishes of Ambrosden, Banbury, Bicester, Blackthorn, Bodicote, Bucknell, Caversfield, Chesterton, Drayton and Hanwell within the district of Cherwell.

The parishes of Bicester, Bucknell, Caversfield, and Chesterton will be altered with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

The parishes of Ambrosden, Banbury, Blackthorn, Bodicote, Drayton and Hanwell will be altered with effect from 1 April 2016. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of elections in 2016.

### **The Sevenoaks (Community Governance Reorganisation) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Sevenoaks District Council for a change to the number of councillors for the parish of Shoreham and for alterations to the areas of parishes and parish wards. The Order was made on 18 September 2013 and will come into force on 1 April 2015.



4. There are ten Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to the constitution of new parishes under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

**The Bournemouth Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community of Governance) (Holdenhurst Village) Order 2013**

This Order created a new parish of Holdenhurst Village and created a parish meeting named Holdenhurst Village Parish Meeting. The Order was made on 5 February 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**The Harborough District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Harborough District council for changes to community governance review (2012/13). It creates a new parish of Shearsby and creates five parish councillors. This Order gives into effect the recommendations of the community governance review dated January 2013.

**The Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council (Balsall Parish) (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Balsall, the creation of the parish Chadwick End and the creation of the parish council for Chadwick End within the Borough of Solihull. This Order took effect on 1 April 2014.

**The Central Bedfordshire Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2012**

This Order created a new parish of Fairfield with a parish council of 7 councillors. The new parish ceases to be part of the parish of Stotfold. Elections will be held on and after the ordinary day of elections 2013. This Order was made on 14 June 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**The Cheshire East Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Crewe) Order 2013**

This Order created a new parish of Crewe with a parish council of 20 councillors. The new parish will have 6 wards. The new parish ceases to be part of the unparished area of Cheshire East. Elections for the new parish will be held on 4 April 2013, 2015 and then thereafter every four years.

The Order also made changes to the Leighton Parish, to include within the Leighton Urban Ward of the parish the unparished part of the borough ward of Leighton.

The Order was made on 17 January 2013 and came into effect on 1 April

2013. The electoral arrangements for the parish council came into effect in respect of parish elections held on 4 April 2013.

**The Leeds (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Rawdon Parish Council) Order 2012**

This Order created a new parish of Rawdon with a parish council of 9 councillors. Elections were held in November 2012 and the Order provides for the next elections in 2015 and then every four years thereafter. The Order was made on 10 October 2012 and came into effect on 15 October 2012.

**The Mid Suffolk District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Darmsden) Order 2012**

This Order created a new parish of Darmsden and parish meeting. The new parish ceases to be part of the parish of Barking. The Order was made on 20 December 2012 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**The North Hertfordshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

The Order abolished the parish and parish council of Letchworth Garden City. The Order was made on 11 February 2013 and shall come into effect on 31 March 2013.

**The North Kesteven District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011**

This Order created two new parishes of South Hykeham and Aubourn with Haddington. The Order abolished the parish of Braucewell and the area became part of the parish of Cranwell & Byards Leap, the new name for the parish is Cranwell, Byards Leap & Braucewell.

The Order also made changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Braucewell, Cranwell & Byards Leap, Doddington & Whisby, North Hykeham, South Hykeham and Thorpe on the Hill.

The Order also made changes to the parish wards of the parishes of Metheringham, Ashby de la Launde & Bloxtiorm, and Temple High Grange and provided for the number of parish councillors for the parish of Dogdye to be 7, for the parish of Metheringham to be 13 and for the parish of Navenby to be 11.

The Order was made on 8 February 2011 and came into effect on 1 March 2011.

### **Chesil Bank Group Parish Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011**

This Order increases the total number of Parish Councillors to be elected for the Chesil Bank Group Parish Council to 14 (from the previous number of 12). It increases the number of Parish Councillors for Portesham Parish Meeting from four to six Parish Councillors. This Order was made on 8 March 2011; it came into force on the 5 May 2011.

### **The Northampton Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northampton for: the alteration of the areas of the parishes of Hardingstone, Great Houghton, Upton, Collingtree and Wootton and East Hunsbury within the district of Northampton; the creation of the parishes of Hunsbury Meadows and West Hunsbury; and the splitting of Wootton and East Hunsbury into the parishes of East Hunsbury; and Wootton, Wootton Fields and Simpson Manor Parish Council.

The creation of the new parishes of Hunsbury Meadows and West Hunsbury and the alteration of the parishes of Hardingstone, Great Houghton, Upton, Collingtree and Wootton and East Hunsbury took effect on 1 April 2013. The electoral arrangements came in effect in respect of parish election held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013.

The creation of the parishes of East Hunsbury and Wootton, Wootton Fields and Simpson Manor and the abolition of the parish of Wootton and East Hunsbury will take effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish election to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The City of Westminster (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013**

The Order created a new parish of Queen's Park. The parish shall have the alternative style of a community and shall therefore be called The Queen's Park Community Council. The parish has 4 wards with 3 councillors for each ward. Elections will be held on the ordinary day of election in 2014. The Order was made on the 1 October 2013 and came into effect on the 1 April 2014. The electoral arrangements came into effect in respect of parish elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2014.

5. There is one local authority that have given notice of change of style under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

**Change of style from Blakelaw and North Fenham Parish Council to Blakelaw and North Fenham Community Council (Newcastle District Council)**

Blakelaw and North Fenham Parish Council changed its style to Blakelaw and North Fenham Community Council. The change came into effect of 14 March 2013.

6. There are seven Orders made under the Local Government Act 1972 conferring on parish meetings the functions of a parish council.

**The Britwell Salome Parish Meeting (Functions) Order 2013 (South Oxfordshire District Council)**

This Order conferred on Britwell Salome Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on 4 January 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

**The Parish of Compton Pauncefoot and Blackford Order 2012 (South Somerset District Council)**

This Order conferred on Compton Pauncefoot and Blackfoot Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on 14 December 2012 and came into effect on the same day.

**The Hunston Parish Meeting Order 2012 (Mid Suffolk District Council)**

This Order conferred on Hunston Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on 27 September 2012 and came into effect on the same day.

**The Little Wolford Parish Meeting Order 2013 (Stratford-on-Avon District Council)**

This Order conferred on Little Wolford Meeting the functions of some of a parish council. The Order was made on 6 March 2013 and came into effect on 1 April 2013.

**Melcombe Horsey Parish Meeting Oder 2013 (West Dorset District Council)**

This Order conferred on Melcombe Horsey Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on the 11 July 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

### **Debach Parish Meeting Order 2013 (Suffolk Coastal District Council)**

This Order conferred on Debach Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on the 19 September 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

### **Mappowder Parish Meeting Order 2013 (North Dorset District Council)**

This Order conferred on Mappowder Parish Meeting the functions of a parish council. The Order was made on the 24 September 2013 and came into effect on the same day.

7. There are sixteen Orders under the Local Government Act 1972 making temporary appointments to parish councils

### **Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council (Temporary Appointment of Parish and Community Councils)**

This Order was made on 20 July 2012 and made temporary appointments to Kingsclere Parish Council. On the 13 September 2012 an election was held and nine members have formally accepted office as Kingsclere Parish Councillors.

### **East Cambridgeshire District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Snailwell Parish Council) Order 2012**

This Order was made on 23 November 2012 and made temporary appointments to Snailwell Parish Council.

### **Selby District Council - Escrick Parish Council (Temporary Appointment of Parish Councillors) Order 2013**

This Order was made on 1 February 2013 and made temporary appointments to Escrick Parish Council.

### **Suffolk Coastal District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Walberswick Parish Council) Order 2012**

This Order was made on 6 November 2012 and made temporary appointments to Walberswick Parish Council.

### **Swale Borough Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Oare Parish Council) Order 2012**

This Order was made on 4 October 2012 and made temporary appointments to Oare Parish Council.

**Wealden District Council (Temporary Appointment of Parish Councillors) Order 2012**

This Order was made on 27 June 2012 and made temporary appointments to Laughton Parish Council.

**District of Maldon (Temporary Appointment of Members of Althorne Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 10 May 2013 and made temporary appointments to Althorne Parish Council

**West Berkshire Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Enborne Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 07 May 2013 and made temporary appointments to Enborne Parish Council.

**South Norfolk Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Kirby Cane and Ellingham Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 14 May 2013 and made temporary appointments to Kirby Cane and Ellingham Parish Council

**South Lakeland Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Arnside Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 23 May 2013 and made temporary appointments to Arnside Parish Council

**Peterborough City Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Marholm Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 6 August 2013. Marholm Parish council was no longer able to act following the resignation of three of the seven Parish councillors. This order allowed Peterborough City council to make a temporary appointment to Marholm Parish Council.

**Hart District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Dogmersfield Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 27 September 2013 and made temporary appointments to Dogmersfield Parish Council. On the 31 October 2013 an election was held and the members formally accepted office as Dogmersfield Parish Councillors.

**Craven District Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Long Preston Parish Council) Order 2013**

This Order was made on the 12 December 2013 and made four temporary appointments to Long Preston Parish Council

**South Norfolk Council (Temporary Appointment of Members of Bixley Parish Council) Order 2014**

This Order was made on the 2 January 2014 and made temporary appointments to Bixley Parish Council.

**Hudswell and District Parish Council Order 2013 (Richmondshire District Council)**

This Order dissolved the parish of Hudswell and grouped the parishes of Hudswell, Downholme, Stainton and Walburn. The Order was made on 10 January 2013 and came into effect on 2 May 2013.

**North Norfolk: Dunton Parish Council (Dissolution) Order 2013**

This Order dissolved the parish of Dunton. The Order was made on the 12 March 2013 and came into effect on the 31 March 2013.

The new boundaries came into effect in respect of county elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013 and district elections to be held on or after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015. The Order was made on 12 November 2012.

### **The District of Craven (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 No. 3150**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Craven District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of county electoral division and district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by The Craven District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011. The Order was made on 20 December 2012. The new boundaries came into effect in respect of county elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013 (article 3) and district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015 (article 4) and 2016 (article 5).

### **The District of Craven (Electoral Changes) (Amendment) Order 2013 No. 221**

This Order amends Schedule 1 to the District of Craven (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 in Order to give full effect to proposals made by Craven District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of county electoral division boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by The Craven District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011. The Order was made on 5 February 2013 and came into effect on the 6 February 2013.

### **The County of Shropshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 No. 2935**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Shropshire Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of county electoral division boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the Shropshire Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Oswestry) Order 2012 and the Shropshire Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Ruyton XI Towns) Order 2012. The new boundaries came into effect in respect of county elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013. The Order was made on 23 November 2012.

**District of West Oxfordshire (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 No. 2993**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by West Oxfordshire District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the West Oxfordshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2011. The Order was made on 29 November 2012. The new boundaries came into effect in respect of district elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2014 (article 3) and 2016 (article 4)

**The North Devon (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 No. 1013**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by North Devon District Council to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by the North Devon District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) No. 1 Order 2011. The Order was made on 4 April 2012. The new boundaries apply in respect of district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 No. 3260**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by the district Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of county electoral division and district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by three Orders, each of which is respectively entitled the King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Parish Boundaries) Order 2012. The Order was made on 20 December 2012. The new boundaries came into effect in respect of county elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013 and district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Kings Lynn and West Norfolk (Electoral Changes) Order 2013 No. 220**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by the district Council of King's Lynn and West Norfolk to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for related alterations of county electoral division and district ward boundaries. These alterations are related to parish boundary changes made by three Orders, each of which is respectively entitled the King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Parish Boundaries) Order 2012. The King's Lynn and West Norfolk (Electoral Changes) Order 2012 is, by article 5 of this Order, revoked. The Order was made on 5 February 2013. The new boundaries came into effect in respect of county elections held on the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2013 and district elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

## Part E

### Consent Cases

1. Wiltshire Council requested that the electoral division names of Wootton Bassett North, Wootton Bassett South and Wootton Bassett East be changed to Royal Wootton Bassett North, Royal Wootton Bassett South and Royal Wootton Bassett East. The Council also requested changes to the parish electoral arrangements in Calne, Corsham, Warminster and Wootton Bassett. The Commission granted consent on 19 December 2012.

2. Bedford Borough Council requested to change the borough ward name from Elstow to Elstow & Stewartby. The Commission granted consent on 20 February 2013.
