### Electoral Review of Lincolnshire

I have been asked to write to you on behalf of West Lindsey District Council's Governance and Audit Committee in order to feed into your consultation.

The review of Boundaries was debated at the Governance and Audit Committee on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2015. The Committee did not discuss specific areas but instead agreed some broad principles that the Committee would like to see reflected in your review and these are detailed below:

- Where possible, County Council boundaries should reflect current district ward boundaries.
- West Lindsey should continue to have 10 members as is the current situation.
- Divisions should aim to have no more than 8000 electors.
- The Committee believes rural and urban areas are very different in nature and therefore should be kept separate wherever possible.
