Dear Sirs,

Thank you for revising the plans for the Lincolnshire County electoral division boundaries and for opening a new phase of consultation.

With regard to the wards covering the Deepings area of South Kesteven, I welcome the changes which have been made which appear to take account of the feedback from interested parties locally including the Town and Parish Councils, the Deepings Heritage group and individuals including myself.

In my opinion, the names of the new wards "Deepings East" and "Deepings West and Rural" are satisfactory. Certainly much better than the previous proposals concerning the west of the Deepings.

The new line between the two wards appears to be mostly coterminous with the existing and historic border between the town of Market Deeping and the village of Deeping St James. This is very helpful as the previous proposal would have been quite confusing and contentious. I note that the properties North of Towngate and West of Peterborough Road fall mostly into the "Deepings East" ward. I assume this is an attempt to 'best-fit' the resultant wards of Market Deeping Town Council and I suppose almost unavoidable. It does most of the industrial estate in "Deepings East" but as this ward is no longer named after the village of Deeping St James I think it will be less of an issue than it was under the original proposal.

Thank you once again for taking local opinions into account.
