**Submission from Littleport Little Downham & Sutton Branch, NE Cambridgeshire Liberal Democrats**

Littleport Little Downham & Sutton Branch of NE Cambridgeshire Liberal Democrats wishes to endorse the proposals for county council boundaries for Cambridgeshire submitted by Cllr Maurice Leeke, and in particular those for East Cambridgeshire. Specifically we note that these proposals are based on eight single-councillor divisions, which we welcome.

We also welcome the way in which Cllr Leeke's proposals keep the parish of Littleport intact in a single division, and also retain the links between the villages in the existing Sutton division. We especially welcome the fact that no parish is split in this process.

We do not support the proposals submitted by East Cambridgeshire District Council.

Whilst they retain the whole parish of Littleport in a single division, they split the parish of Sutton in two, against the expressed wishes of Sutton Parish Council. The village of Sutton has a strong united community identity and the District Council's proposals to cut it in half would be very detrimental to this. Cllr Leeke's proposals demonstrate that it is possible to achieve electoral equality in this part of East Cambridgeshire without dividing Sutton in two.

We hope that the Commission will adopt the proposals put forward by Cllr Leeke.
