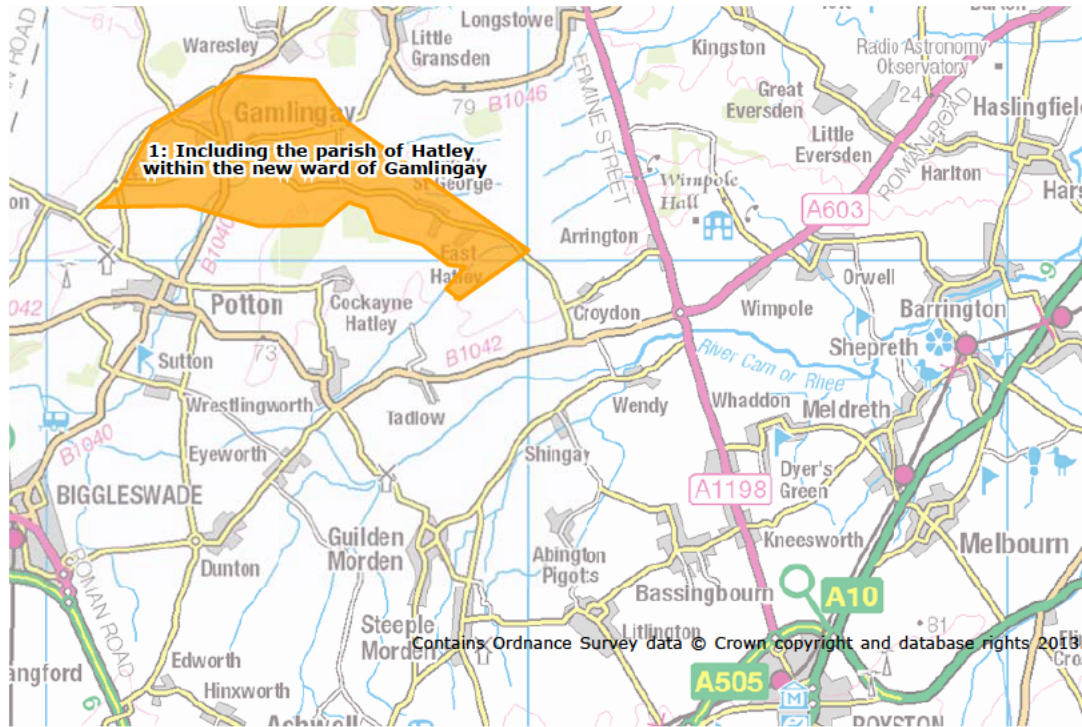

Annotation 1: Including the parish of Hatley within the new ward of Gamlingay

Comment text:

Hatley - four miles from Gamlingay - relies on Gamlingay for employment, shops, schools, doctors, meetings, clubs, pubs, restaurants and entertainment as well as its library and churches, making our ties with Gamlingay very strong. This does not apply to any other village. The local parish magazine, The [Gamlingay] Gazette, describes itself in its masthead as 'The newspaper of Gamlingay, East Hatley and Hatley St George'. The [Gamlingay] Post - its rival - uses a similar description: 'The news magazine of Gamlingay and the Hatleys'. The road through Hatley St George leads to and from Gamlingay. (East Hatley is a cul-de-sac.) The district councillors know Hatley well and have helped to protect the parish from unwarranted development - yes, one lives in Hatley, but the other lives in Gamlingay and would be expected to retain her seat post the proposed 2018 changes, which is by no means certain for the Hatley councillor. As Hatley is not part of the 'natural' territory of The Mordens, there is deep concern someone elected from there might either not know where Hatley is (seriously!) or feel we're too small to bother about. Please keep Hatley within the Gamlingay ward.
