Littleport Parish Councillors considered the proposals in the review and the effect it would have on the Parish.

Members were in total agreement that Littleport should retain representation at East Cambridgeshire District Council with 4 councillors and the Parish is de-warded.

Littleport is a growing village which will see three new schools being built in the next few years; in excess of 500 more houses being built together with industrial units. Littleport benefits from a station with regular services to Cambridge and King's Cross.

The Parish Council objected at the last review to being warded and since then the division of the village has led to much confusion with houses in the same street being in different wards not to mention the complicated division of the boundaries.

The Council therefore respectfully requests the Parish of Littleport is returned to being one ward with 4 representatives.
