**Subject:** North Hykeham representation

Dear Sir,

I am still baffled why the Commission appears still to be insistent on splitting the town of North Hykeham (pop. over 14,000) between three County Council Divisions. I accept that the Hykeham Forum Division, which I have represented since 2001, needs to increase in terms of electors, but what is being proposed takes no account of local loyalties. To link the town with Eagle has been accepted; but never to link it with the village of Waddington.

The least you could do would be to keep the Witham Ward within Hykeham Forum, whilst accepting the need for the Division to take in some, if not all, of the old Mill Ward. Linking it with Waddington may make sense in terms of numbers; but that is all. Please think again.
