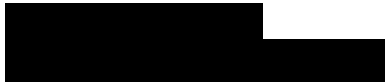
Comments below from Cringleford Parish Council on the proposed boundary review:

“On the whole Cringleford Parish Council would prefer the Cringleford Ward to coincide with the parish of Cringleford. The population of the parish is increasing rapidly as new housing comes on line and will bring it within the threshold for ward status. The administration of the parish has already increased in complexity and will maintain that trajectory for at least another decade. It is important, therefore, that it has the fullest direct representation at the higher levels of local government, the district and the county. If it is impossible to deliver the single parish ward option, the Parish Council would prefer to be linked with Colney, rather than any other parish. Cringleford and Colney are contiguous, but they are also linked socially and economically. Much of the employment for Cringleford residents is found on the expanding Norwich Research Park based in Colney.”
