CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Halton (Parishes) Order 1991

Made - - - - 5th August 1991

Coming into force-
for the purposes referred to
in article 1(2) - - - - 31st. December 1991
for all other purposes - - - 1st. April 1992

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, which gives effect to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(5) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Halton Borough Council about parishes in the borough:

Citation and commencement

- 1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the Halton (Parishes) Order 1991.

- (2) This Order shall come into force on 31st. December 1991 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).
- (3) For all other purposes this Order shall come into force on 1st. April 1992.

Interpretation

2. In this Order-

"boundary map" means one of the 2 maps prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Maps of the Halton (Parishes) Order 1991", duly numbered for reference, and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976; and

"the unparished area" means the unparished area of the borough of Halton.

Transfers from unparished area to parishes

- 3.- (1) The part of the unparished area marked A1 on boundary map 1 shall be transferred to the parish of Moore.
- (2) The part of the unparished area marked A5 on boundary map 2 shall be transferred to the parish of Preston Brook.

Transfers between parishes

- 4.- (1) The part of the parish of Daresbury marked A2 on boundary map 1 shall be transferred to the parish of Moore.

- (2) The part of the parish of Daresbury marked A4 on boundary map 2 shall be transferred to the parish of Preston Brook.
- (3) The part of the parish of Preston Brook marked A3 on boundary map 2 shall be transferred to the parish of Daresbury.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

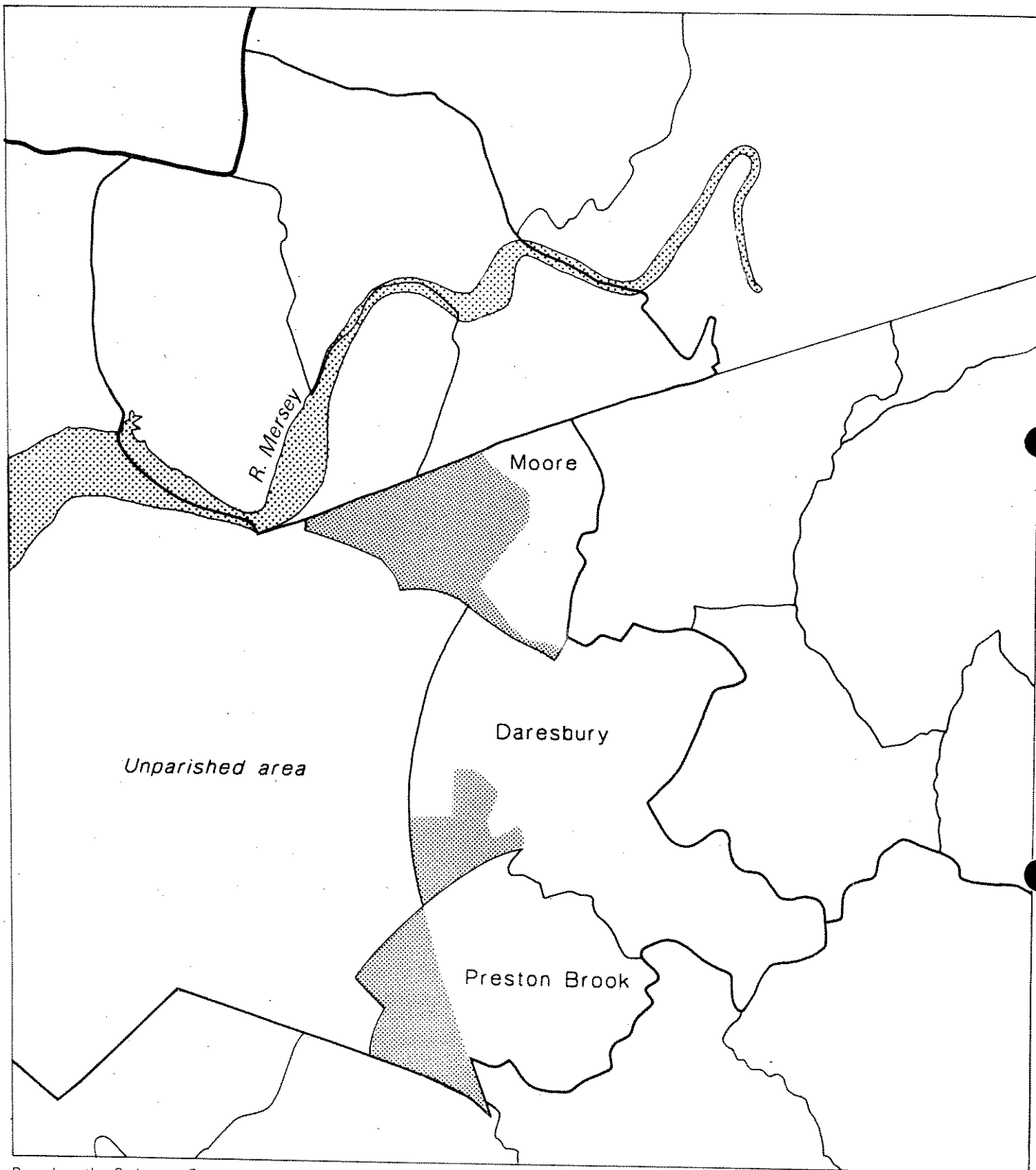
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order changes the boundaries of the parishes of Daresbury, Moore and Preston Brook in the borough of Halton. Two parts of the unparished area of the borough are transferred to Moore and Preston Brook respectively, and three transfers of areas between the parishes are effected.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) gives a general guide to the areas affected. Prints of the detailed boundary map (described in article 2) may be inspected at all reasonable times at the offices of the Halton Borough Council and at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2, Marsham Street, LONDON SW1P 3EB.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (S.I. 1976/246, amended by S.I. 1978/247) contain general provisions regarding the effect of orders such as this one.
