Part A

The Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle Upon Tyne, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside and Sunderland Combined Authority Order 2014 No. 1012

This Order establishes the Durham, Gateshead, Newcastle Upon Tyne, North Tyneside, Northumberland, South Tyneside and Sunderland Combined Authority.

Part 6 of the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 (“the 2009 Act”) provides for the establishment of combined authorities for the areas of two or more local authorities in England. Combined authorities are bodies corporate which may be given power to exercise functions relating to transport and to economic development and regeneration in their area.

The Secretary of State may only establish a combined authority for an area where a scheme for such an authority has been published under section 109 of the 2009 Act. This Order has been made following the publication of such a scheme on 31st July 2013 by the constituent councils whose areas together make up the combined area of the new authority. Changes effected by local authorities' action as notified to the Secretary of State and the Local Government Boundary Commission for England

1. There are fifteen Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to amending electoral arrangements under section 95 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

The South Lakeland District Council (Re-organisation of Community Governance) Order No.1 -2014

The Order states that all parish councillors for Natland Parish Council will be elected on the ordinary day of elections in 2014

The Durham County Council (Reorganisation of Governance) Order 2014

This Order changes the number of parish councillors to be elected to the parish of Greencroft.

The Hart District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Elvetham Heath) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Hart District Council for the increase of Parish Councillors for the parish of Elvetham Heath, within the district of Hart.

The Forest Heath District (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Kentford) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Forest Heath District Council for governance of the parish of Kentford. The number of parish councillors for the parish of Kentford shall be 7.

The East Cambridgeshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by East Cambridgeshire District Council for the decrease of numbers of Parish Councillors for the Parish Council of Little Thetford from 9 to 7. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of Councillors in 2015.

The Forest Heath District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Kentford) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Forest Heath District Council for governance of the parish of Kentford.

The Mid Suffolk District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Stuston) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Mid Suffolk District Council for the form of governance for the parish of Stuston to be changed from a Parish Council to a Parish Meeting, with effect from 1 April 2015.

The District of New Forest (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by New Forest District Council to change the number of Parish Councillors for the parish of Sway to be 12.

The Warrington Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Cuerdley) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Warrington Borough Council for the dissolution of Cuerdley Parish Council and the creation of Cuerdley Parish Meeting.

Cornwall Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cornwall Council to change the number of Parish Councillors for the parish of St Austell Bay to 9. 4 parish councillors for Charlestown Parish Ward, 4 parish councillors for Duporth Parish Ward and 1 parish councillor for Porthpean and Trenarren Parish Ward.

The Bassetlaw District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Bassetlaw District Council for the creation of the parish of Norton and Cuckney Parish which was previously two separate parishes of Cuckney and Norton. The Order dissolves the group of parishes of North Wheatley and South Wheatley and amalgamates the separate parishes into one new parish council called North and South Wheatley Parish. The Order changes the number of parish councillors for the parishes of Eaton, Gamston, West Drayton and Harworth and Bircotes and also abolishes the existing parish wards East and West in Harworth and Bircotes parish.

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Newton-on-the-Moor and Swarland) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Newton on the Moor and Swarland to be 10

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Whalton) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the existing wards of the parish of Whatton to be abolished and for the number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Whatton to be nine.

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Meldon) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the existing wards of the parish of Meldon to be abolished and for the number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Meldon to be nine.

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parish of Togston) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for the number of parish councillors to be elected for the parish of Togston to be 7.

2. There are eighteen Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to changes to boundaries and electoral arrangements of parishes under section 88 and the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

The Bolsover District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Bolsover District Council for the alteration of the area of the parishes of Whitwell and Elmton with Creswell.

The District of Harborough (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Harborough District Council for changes to community governance arrangements arising from a district wide community governance review (2012/13)

Slough Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance No 1) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Slough Borough Council. The Order makes alterations to the parish area of Britwell, specifies the number of parish councillors for the parish of Britwell and alters the electoral cycle of Britwell.

Blaby District Council Community Governance Reorganisation Order (Braunstone Town Council – BTC1) 2014

This order changes the number of wards and boundaries for Braunstone Town Council.

The Newark and Sherwood District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Newark and Sherwood District Council for the alteration of the parish area of Newark Town Council, Coddington Parish Council, Balderton Parish Council, Hawton Parish Council and Farndon Parish Council. The Order came into force on 1 April 2014.

The Rugby Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Rugby Borough Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Cawston within the borough of Rugby. The parish of Cawston will be altered with effect from 1 October 2014. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

The Forest Heath District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Wangford) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Forest Heath District Council. The Order amalgamates the existing town of Brandon and the existing

parish of Wangford to create a new parish called Brandon. The previous town of Brandon and parish of Wangford shall cease to exist.

The Horsham District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Horsham District Council for the alteration of the parish area of Shipley and Southwater, the number of parish councillors for the parish of Storrington and Sullington shall be 15, the amalgamation of the exiting parish wards of Storrington and Sullington and a change of election cycle for both the parish of Southwater and the parish of Storrington and Sullington.

The Tonbridge and Malling District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order revokes the Tonbridge and Malling District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2013. The Order alters the parish boundaries of the parish of Ryarsh and the parish of Leybourne and alters the number of parish councillors for the parish of Leybourne to 11.

The Bedford Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order, 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Bedford Borough Council for the alterations of the areas of the parishes of Ravensden and Brickhill. In consequence of these changes the existing parish wards for Brickhill are abolished and new wards are created, and the creation of a parish ward for Woodlands Park within Brickhill Parish.

The Cotswold District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to the recommendations made by Cotswold District Council following a Community Governance Review of the Parishes of the District. The new electoral arrangements will apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

The Rutland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Rutland County Council for the alteration of the areas of the parishes of Cottesmore and Greetham.

The East Northamptonshire District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by East Northamptonshire District Council for the alteration of the parish areas of Lutton, Warmington, Raunds, Ringstead, Irthlingborough, Stanwick, Higham Ferrers, Chelveston-cum-Caldecott, Thrapston, Islip and Rushden. The Order also changes the electoral arrangements for Thrapston and the number of parish councillors for Ashton.

The Purbeck District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Purbeck District Council for the amalgamation of the parishes of Tyneham and Steeple and to create a new parish of Steeple with Tyneham and the alteration of the areas of Affpuddle and Turnerspudde, Arne, Bere Regis, Corfe Castle, Morden, Wareham, Wareham St Martin, and Worth Matravers within the district of Purbeck.

The Northumberland (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Parishes of Horncliffe and Norham) Order 2014

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Northumberland County Council for an area of the parish of Norham to be transferred to the parish of Horncliffe.

The Durham County Council (Reorganisation of Governance) Order 2014 (2)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Durham County Council. The Order alters the parish boundaries of the parish of Shincliffe and the parish of Cassop-Cum-Quarrington.

The Sevenoaks District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2014 No2

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Sevenoaks District Council for a change to the number of parish councillors for the parish of Shoreham and for alterations to the areas of parishes and parish wards in the schedule.

The South Lakeland District Council (Re-organisation of Community Governance) Order No.2 – 2014

The Order gives effect to recommendations made by South Lakeland District Council for alteration of the parish area of Hughill, change of name for the parish of Urswick to Urswick, Bardsea and Stainton Parish Council, for the creation of a new parish of Skelsmergh and Scalthwaiteregg and the creation of a new parish of Witherslack, Meathop and Ulpha.
