**Re: Electoral Review of Forest of Dean  
Warding Arrangements**

I write on behalf of the Town Council which discussed this matter at a recent meeting

The Council would like to suggest that the parish boundary runs up the Gorse to Lower Road and along the centre of Lower Road to join the existing boundary at Woodgate Road: Thus removing Grove Road, Marians Walk and Marians Lane from the parish.

The Council would ask that the Fairways and Roman Way developments along with High Nash are moved from Coleford East into Coleford Central ward. This would make a much more coherent division of the parish. Each of these new wards would only require 2 councillors thus reducing Coleford representation by 1 councillor.

The Town Council would urge you to make these amendments
