## LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND

### The Halton (Parishes) Order 2007

Made 18 October 2007

*Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14 and 23 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997(a), makes the following Order which gives effect (with modification) to petitions under section 11 of that Act

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. — (1) This Order may be cited as the Halton (Parishes) Order 2007.

(2) It shall come into force —

(a) for the purposes of this article and proceedings preliminary or relating to elections of parish councillors to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2008, on the day after that on which it is made;

(b) for all other purposes, on 1st April 2008.

(3) In this Order—

“the new parishes” means the parishes constituted by article 2 and 3; and

“maps 1 and 2” mean the maps prepared by the Department for Communities and Local Government, marked “Maps referred to in the Halton (Parishes) Order 2007” and deposited in accordance with regulation 6(1) of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999(b).

**Constitution of new parish of Halebank**

2. —(1) A new parish, comprising the area outlined in blue on map 1, shall be constituted within the district of Halton

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Halebank.

**Constitution of new parish of Sandymoor**

3. —(1) A new parish, comprising the area outlined in blue on map 2, shall be constituted within the district of Halton.

(2) The name of the new parish shall be Sandymoor

**Directions to establish parish councils**

4. The Halton Borough Council is hereby directed to establish parish councils for the new parishes

**Transitional Provisions**

5. —(1) Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish of Halebank at the elections to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2008 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by those persons who, immediately before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008, are the elected councillors for the district ward of Ditton

(2) Until the councillors elected to the council of the new parish of Sandymoor at the elections to be held on the ordinary day of elections in 2008 come into office, the new parish shall be represented by those persons who, immediately before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008, are the elected councillors for the district ward of Daresbury.

**Order Date**

6. 1st April 2008 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order gives effect (with modification) to petitions sent to the Secretary of State for the creation as parishes of areas within the district of Halton and for the establishment of parish councils for those areas. The modification relates to the proposed boundary of Halebank Parish, which the Secretary of State has concluded requires a slight amendment. A map forming part of this note gives a general guide to the area concerned.

Article 2 creates a new parish to be called Halebank.

Article 3 creates a new parish to be called Sandymoor.

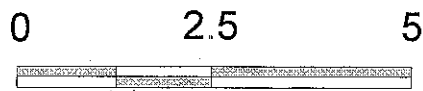
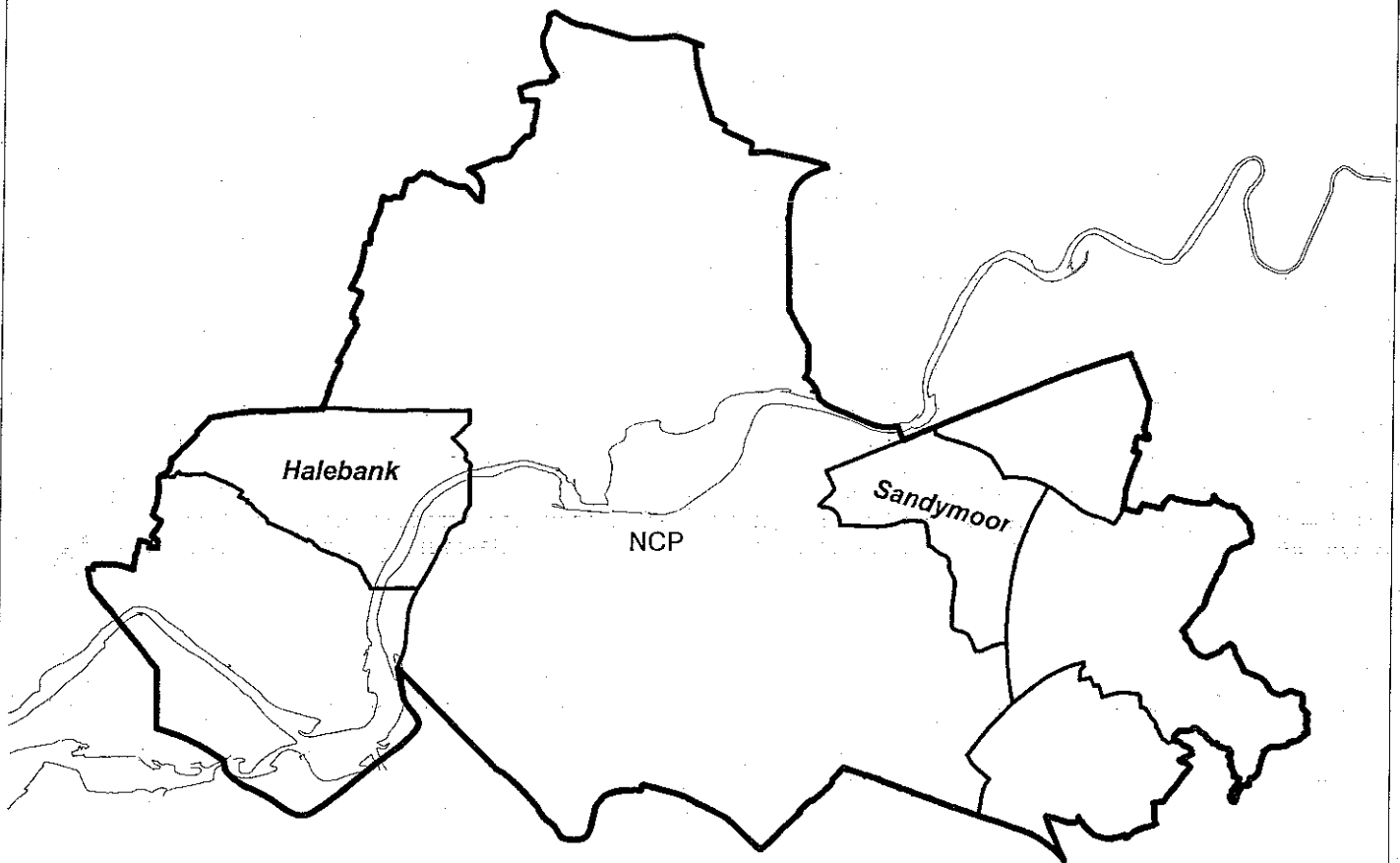
Article 4 directs the Halton Borough Council to establish parish councils for the new parishes.

Article 5(1) provides for the parish of Halebank to be represented by the district councillors elected for the district ward of Ditton until councillors for the new parish, to be elected on the ordinary day of election in 2008, come into office.

Article 5(2) provides for the parish of Sandymoor to be represented by the district councillors elected for the district ward of Daresbury until councillors for the new parish, to be elected on the ordinary day of election in 2008, come into office.

Article 6 specifies 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008 as the Order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils) Regulations 1999, which make provision of general application in relation to orders such as this Order.
