I am the Nottinghamshire County Councillor for the Nuthall Division which comprises the current two Broxtowe Borough Council Wards of Nuthall East and Strelley and Nuthall West and Watnall. I have seen the Borough Council's proposals for Broxtowe as agreed at a recent full meeting of the Council and agree with the changes they are proposing to the two Borough Council wards that make up my current County Division, (I appreciate that there will be a subsequent County Boundary Review). However, I have one disagreement and that is in the proposed name for the existing Nuthall West and Watnall Ward. The Borough Council are suggesting that it should be called Greasley Watnall and Nuthall West. The term 'Greasley' is confusing and irrelevant and doesn't match the other adjacent ward of Nuthall East and Strelley. Whilst Watnall is a separate but closely integrated part of the wider Nuthall community it has no significant geographical alignment with the Parish of Greasley and no-one living at Watnall gives their address with any reference to Greasley. The name of the ward should be 'Nuthall West and Watnall'.
