The Vale of White Horse District Council, in exercise of the power in section 109 of the Local Government Act 1972 and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following order –

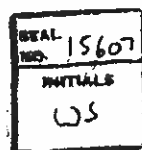
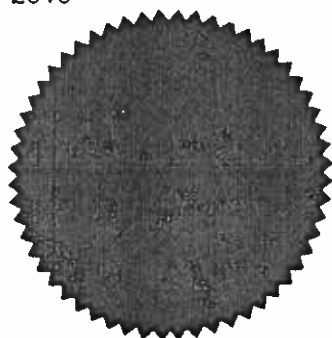
1. With effect from the date of this order, the Vale of White Horse District Council confers on the parish meeting of the parish of Wytham in the county of Oxfordshire the functions of a parish council under section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972.
2. This order may be cited as the Wytham Parish Meeting (Functions) Order 2010.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(this note is not part of the order)

- 1 Section 109 of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that on the application of the parish meeting of a parish not having a separate parish council, the district council may, subject to the provisions of the grouping order if the parish is grouped with any other parish, by order confer on the parish meeting any functions of a parish council.
- 2 Section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972 provides a power to incur expenditure for certain purposes not otherwise authorised.
