**ELECTORAL REVIEW OF CAMBRIDGESHIRE: NEW DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS**

Thank you for your letter dated 6<sup>th</sup> June 2016 and confirming my telephone conversation with you this afternoon.

I have approached the Manageress who oversees the 56 apartment block – namely, Cavendish Court; She will advise as many residents as possible to write giving their views regarding the Boundary Change Review. (I advised my own age of 87 years but there are some much older residents here – one even 97 years of age) and being mindful of these facts I am sure you will understand our dismay at a change of boundary is beyond our belief. I was always under the impression that “if a thing is working well, don't change it!!

As mentioned during our conversation there is a River between Cavendish Court and the proposal to align us with LITTLE PAXTON & PRIORY PARK – an area I am unable to walk to due both to age and having to rely on taxis to get me around, outside of St. Neots town.

A further point to mention is that I am given to understand from you that it is possible Post Codes will not be affected but of course the change from “Eaton Ford” to “Litte Paxton & Priory Park” will still entail all residents here being faced with postal charges advising various official bodies such as Banks plus their family and friends, with no recompense from your department for the costs involved.

Finally I do not object to my responses (both letter contents) being made public but please refrain from revealing my name.
