At present St Briavels is linked with Newland. We rarely join with that village for activities or any other reason. Hewelsfield and Brockweir are much closer and there are many activities at which all three villages participate. The village shop in Brockweir is served by St Briavels residents as well as those from Hewelsfield and Brockweir. Children from the latter villages attend St Briavels school. The churches of all three villages unite for services and fundraising events. Concerts held in St Briavels are attended by residents from the other villages. St Briavels residents attend the Local History Group meetings in Brockweir. Entertainment in all villages is attended by residents of all three villages. Further education, sporting and exercise classes are held in both Brockweir and St Briavels and are attended by residents of all three villages. For many reasons residents from St Briavels go to Brockweir and Hewelsfield and Brockweir residents come up to St Briavels. The three villages support one another in many ways. It would seem logical to link the three villages within an electoral boundary rather than St Briavels being linked with Newland and Hewelsfield and Brockweir being linked with Wollaston as they are at present.
