Dear Sir / Madam,

On behalf of Harston Parish Council, I wish to comment on the draft recommendations for new ward boundaries in South Cambridgeshire.

The recommendations show Harston as being part of a large ward entitled "Harston and Comberton Ward". In this new Ward, Harston is grouped with Comberton, Grantchester, Coton and Barton. These are villages with which we have little in common and little contact. Hence, we do not support this recommendation.

We would prefer either the existing organisation whereby Harston is grouped with Hauxton only in a ward with One District Councillor. Were that not to be possible, we would prefer to be grouped with Hauxton and other villages along the A10: Foxton, Melbourn, Shepreth and Meldrith. This is because we have considerable contact with these villages, including a Chairs of the Parish Councils Committee. This dominant local relationship is based on the Royston to Cambridge Corridor with the A10 [traffic, bus services etc] and the Cambridge to King's Cross railway [frequent closings of the level crossing at Foxton and local stations].
