LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES
CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS
The Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1986

Made 26th February 1986
Coming into Operation -
for the purposes described
in article 2(1) 3rd March 1986
for all other purposes 1st April 1986

Whereas the Cherwell District Council, acting pursuant to section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a), has made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals about parish boundary changes within the district:

And whereas in consequence of those recommendations the Commission has seen fit, pursuant to sections 47, 48(9) and 51(1) of that Act, to make proposals to the Secretary of State:

And whereas more than six weeks has elapsed since those proposals were made:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to the proposals:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:-

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1986.

(a) 1972 c.70.

2. - (1) 3rd March 1986 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).

(2) For all other purposes, this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1986.

Interpretation

3. In this order -

"the boundary maps" means the 14 maps (duly numbered for reference) which are issued by the Department of the Environment as the "Maps of the Cherwell (Parishes) Order 1986";

"county electoral division" means an electoral division of the county of Oxfordshire;

"district ward" means a ward of the district of Cherwell;

"the former borough" means the former municipal borough of Banbury; and

"the 1976 Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations mentioned in article 2(1).

Transfers between parishes

4. Each area marked on the boundary maps as shown in columns 1 and 2 of the Schedule hereto shall be transferred from the relevant parish named in column 3 to that named in column 4.

Where in column 5 there is mentioned in relation to any area -

- (a) a parish ward;
- (b) a district ward;
- (c) a county electoral division; or
- (d) a petty sessional division -

that area shall additionally be transferred to that ward or division.

Parts of Bodicote and Hanwell ceasing to form part of any parish

5. -(1) The part of the parish of Bodicote which is marked B1 on boundary map 3 shall cease to form part of any parish, and shall be transferred to the Easington district ward, and to the Banbury Easington county electoral division.

(2) The part of the parish of Hanwell which is marked B2 on boundary map 6 shall cease to form part of any parish, and shall be transferred to the Hardwick district ward, and to the Banbury Hardwick county electoral division.

Unparished area to form part of Bodicote

6. The part of the area of the former borough marked C1 on boundary map 3 shall be transferred to the district ward and parish of Bodicote, and to the Bloxham county electoral division.

Statutory definitions of areas, etc.

7. -(1) For the purposes of regulation 40 (statutory definitions of areas) of the 1976 Regulations, any reference to the area of the former borough shall be construed as -

(a) including the areas mentioned in article 5; and

(b) excluding the part mentioned in article 6.

(2) Regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the 1976 Regulations shall apply to the area of the former borough as if it were a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41(2). For the purposes of any provision in force to which that regulation applies, that area shall include the areas mentioned in article 5, and exclude the part mentioned in article 6.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order.)

This order affects parishes and the unparished area of Banbury in the district of Cherwell.

It transfers areas between parishes, and between the unparished area and the parishes of Bodicote and Hanwell.

The maps forming part of this note (pages 7 and 8) give a general guide to the areas affected by this order as from 1st April 1986.

Prints of the detailed boundary maps referred to in article 3 may be inspected at the offices of the district council, and may be inspected at or purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library, 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

Consequential changes to local government electoral areas are made.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976, mentioned in articles 2(1), 3 and 7, contain further provisions about the effect and implementation of orders such as the present one.

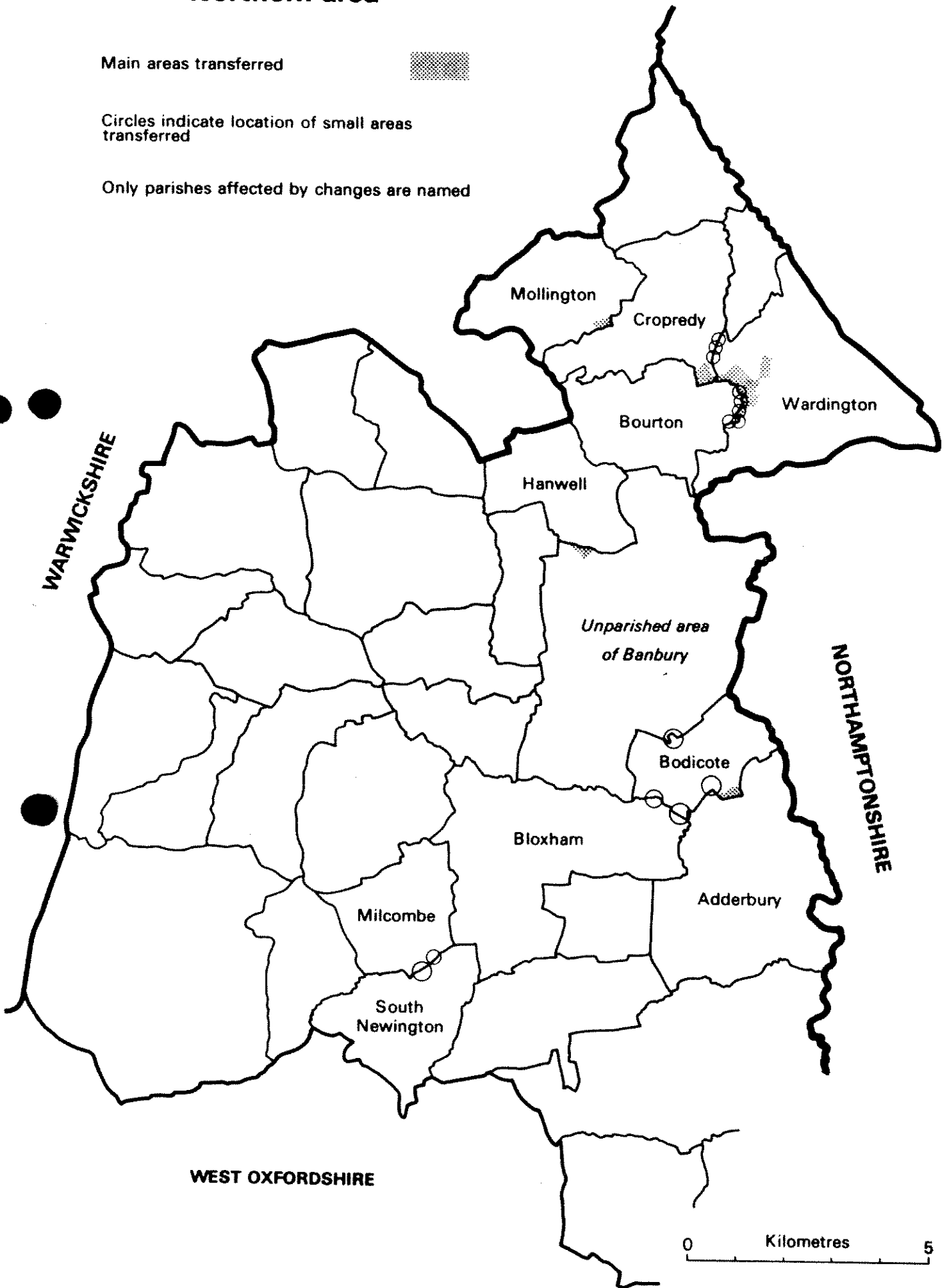
Northern area
