CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Macclesfield (Parishes) Order 1991

Made - - - - 13th November 1991

Coming into force-
for the purposes referred to
in article 1(2) - - - - 1st December 1991

for all other purposes - - - 1st. April 1992

The Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order, which gives effect with modifications to proposals submitted to him under sections 47, 48(5) and 51(1) of that Act, more than six weeks before the making of this Order, by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England following recommendations made to them under section 48(8) of that Act by the Macclesfield Borough Council about parishes in the borough:

Citation and commencement

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the Macclesfield (Parishes) Order 1991.

- (2) This Order shall come into force on 1st December 1991 for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (a).
- (3) For all other purposes this Order shall come into force on 1st. April 1992.

Interpretation

2. In this Order-

- "the borough" means the borough of Macclesfield, and
"borough ward" means a ward of that borough;
"boundary map" means one of the 3 maps prepared by the Department of the Environment, marked "Maps of the Macclesfield (Parishes) Order 1991", duly numbered for reference, and deposited in accordance with regulation 5 of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976; and
"the unparished area" means the unparished area of the borough.

Transfers from unparished area to parish of Higher Hurdsfield

- 3.- The parts of the unparished area marked A and B on map 1 shall be transferred to the parish of Higher Hurdsfield, to the Rainow ward, and to the Bollington and Disley electoral division of the county of Cheshire.

Transfers between parishes

- 4.- (1) The part of the parish of Bollington marked B on map 2 shall be transferred to the parish of Higher Hurdsfield, and to the Rainow ward.

- (2) The part of the parish of Higher Hurdsfield marked A on map 2 shall be transferred to the parish of Bollington, and to the Bollington East ward.
- (3) The parts of the parish of Higher Hurdsfield marked A, C, D and F on map 3 shall be transferred to the parish of Rainow.
- (4) The parts of the parish of Rainow marked B and E on map 3 shall be transferred to the parish of Higher Hurdsfield.

(This note is not part of the Order)

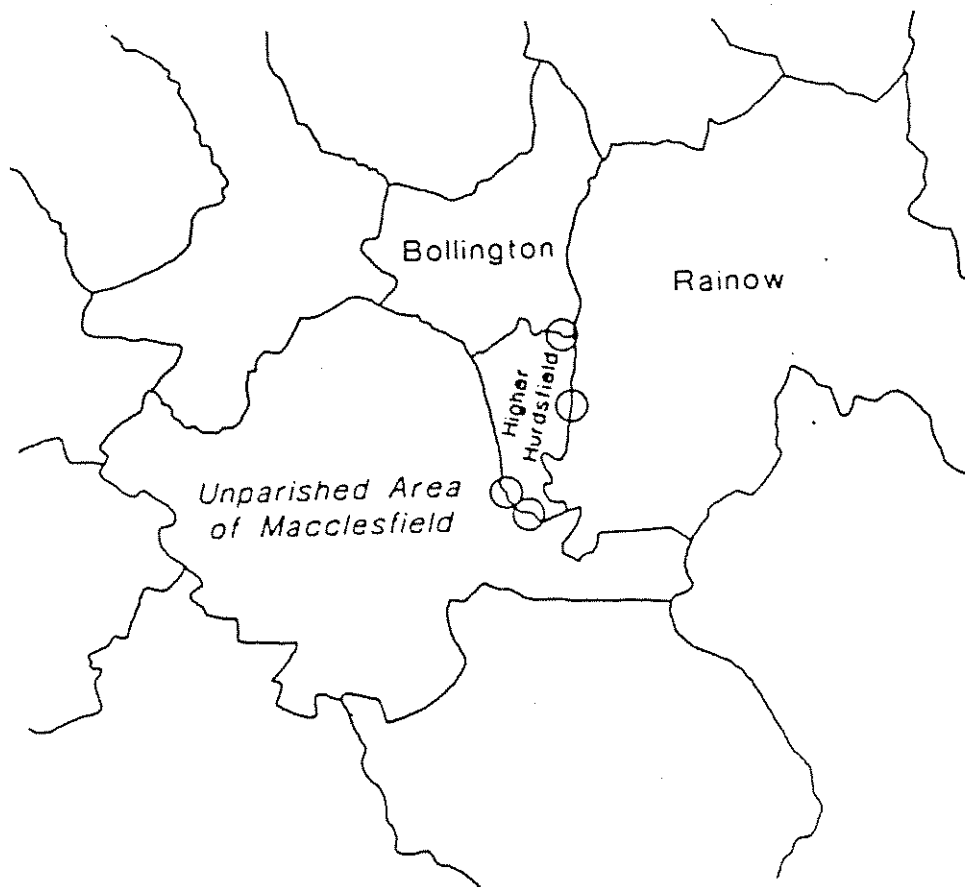
This Order affects parishes in the borough of Macclesfield by-

- (a) transferring two parts of the unparished area of the borough to the parish of Higher Hurdsfield; and
- (b) making minor adjustments to the boundaries of the the parishes of Higher Hurdsfield, Bollington, and Rainow.

The map forming part of this note (page 4) gives a general guide to the areas affected. Prints of the detailed boundary map (described in article 2) may be inspected at all reasonable times at the offices of the Macclesfield Borough Council and at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB.

The Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976 (S.I. 1976/246, amended by S.I. 1978/247) contain general provisions regarding the effect of orders such as this one.
