We wondered if you could take our comments into account when making your decision regarding the Boundary Review for South Norfolk.

We are the District Councillor's for Poringland with the Framingham's, South Norfolk Council's proposal to you splits Poringland and the Framingham's, so a different Councillor would look after each village.

We don't think this would work as Poringland and Framingham Earl is like one village, there is no countryside between these villages, one side of the street is Poringland and the other side is Framingham Earl, there are also housing estates where one house is in Poringland and their neighbours fall into Framingham Earl eg. in The Street, Poringland, Tulip Tree Drive is in Framingham Earl, walk across the road the chemist is in Poringland, then walk 10 metres from the chemist and both sides of the road are in Poringland. This is an example of the fine boundaries in Poringland/ Framingham Earl, it's just the cats eyes on the road that define the boundaries.

Therefore to split them so they have a different Councillor would confuse residents, and they wouldn't then know who to contact.
