PROPOSALS FOR THE FUTURE ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS
FOR THE BOROUGH OF GRIMSBY

1. We, the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, having carried out our initial review of the electoral arrangements for the Borough of Grimsby, in accordance with the requirements of section 63 of, and Schedule 9 to, the Local Government Act 1972, present our proposals for the future electoral arrangements for that borough.
2. In accordance with the procedure laid down in section 60(1) and (2) of the 1972 Act, notice was given on 31 January 1974 that we were to undertake this review. This was incorporated in a consultation letter addressed to the Borough Council, copies of which were circulated to Humberside County Council, the Member of Parliament for the constituency concerned and the headquarters of the main political parties. Copies were also sent to the editors of local newspapers circulating in the area and of the local government press. Notices inserted in the local press announced the start of the review and invited comments from members of the public and interested bodies.
3. The Grimsby Borough Council were invited to prepare a draft scheme of representation for our consideration. When doing so, they were asked to observe the rules laid down in Schedule 11 to the Local Government Act 1972 and the guidelines which we set out in our Report No 6 about the proposed size of council and the proposed number of councillors for each ward. They were also asked to take into account any views expressed to them following their consultations with local interests. We therefore asked that they should publish details of the provisional proposals about a month before they submitted their draft scheme to us, thus allowing an opportunity for local comment.
4. The Borough Council have passed a resolution under section 7(4)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972 requesting a system of elections by thirds.

5. On 25 June 1974 the Borough Council submitted two draft schemes of representation. Their preferred scheme provided for 14 wards each electing 3 councillors to form a council of 42 members. The second scheme which provided for 22 2-member wards, a total of 44, had been drawn up to be compatible with the future county council electoral arrangements. It was then expected locally that the borough of Grimsby would be represented by 11 councillors on a county council of 99 members.

6. We considered the Council's draft scheme and the alternative schemes which had been presented to us by a local political association and a local councillor. At this time discussions took place about the future size of the county council and Humberside County Council made various suggestions for a membership of 99, 92 and 95 councillors. Having looked at the problem in relation to all the counties in England, we considered that a council of 70-75 members would be more appropriate for a county the size of Humberside. In view of the lack of agreement about the future county council size we decided to make proposals for the borough of Grimsby without prejudice to any future county electoral arrangements. We decided that the Borough Council's draft scheme for 22 wards provided a satisfactory basis for representation in accordance with the requirements of Schedule 11 to the 1972 Act and our guidelines and we adopted it as our draft proposals, subject only to some minor boundary modifications recommended by the Ordnance Survey.

7. On 30 June 1975 we issued our draft proposals and these were sent to all who had received our consultation letter or had commented on the Council's draft schemes. The Council were asked to make the draft proposals, and the accompanying map which defined the proposed ward boundaries, available for inspection at their main offices. Representations on our draft proposals were invited from those to whom they were circulated and, by public notices, from other members of the public and interested bodies. We asked for comments to reach us by 22 August 1975.

8. We received objections to our draft proposals from the Borough Council, a local political party, a local political association, a local ratepayers' association and a councillor, writing as an individual elector.

In the light of these representations and in view of the continuing uncertainty about the future size of the county council, we decided to allow the Borough Council and others an opportunity to reconsider their proposals and to submit revised schemes. Our invitation was issued on 8 December 1975.

9. On 17 December 1976, the Borough Council submitted a revised draft scheme. The scheme provided for 21 wards each electing 2 councillors to form a council of 42 members and was based substantially on our draft proposals but with amendments which took account of revised forecast electorate figures. We received no other proposals.

10. Having studied the revised scheme, we noted that the representation was uneven and that a better standard of representation could be achieved by adopting the pattern of wards in our draft proposals but with changes in the representation of the Pelham, West and Willows wards and modifications to the boundaries of the Bradley and West wards and the Wallow and Central wards; the resulting scheme produced a council of 45 members.

11. Accordingly on 27 July we issued revised draft proposals incorporating these modifications, with the same publicity as we gave to our previous draft proposals in June 1975 (see para 7 above). We asked for comments to reach us by 5 October 1977.

12. Grimsby Borough Council accepted the revised proposals without amendment. Humberside County Council informed us that they had no comment to make. The local councillor mentioned in paragraph 8 above reiterated the suggestions which he had made before for re-drawing the proposed Alexandra and Gilbey wards and making a minor alteration to the boundary between the proposed Scartho and Wintringham wards.

13. We reviewed our draft proposals in the light of these comments. We noted that the proposal for the Alexandra and Gilbey wards would produce an unequal standard of representation. The Scartho/Wintringham boundary in our draft

proposals appeared to us to have general acceptance locally and we decided not to amend it. Accordingly, we confirmed our draft proposals as our final proposals without modification.

14. Details of these final proposals are set out in Schedule 1 to this report and on the attached map. Schedule 2 shows the order of retirement of councillors and Schedule 3 is a detailed description of the boundaries of the proposed wards, as defined on the map.

15. In accordance with section 60(5)(b) of the 1972 Act a copy of this report and a copy of the map are being sent to Grimsby Borough Council and will be made available for public inspection at their main offices. Copies of this report (without map) are being sent to those who received the consultation letter and to those who made comments.

Note: Where the boundary is described as following a road, railway, river, canal or similar feature it should be deemed to follow the centre line of the feature unless otherwise stated.

GREAT COATES WARD

Commencing at the point where the River Freshney meets the western boundary of the Borough, thence northwestwards and following the said Borough boundary and southeastwards along low water to a point due northeast of the eastern end of New Cut Drain adjacent to Pyewipe Road thence due southwestwards to and southwestwards along the said drain to the railway from Grimsby to Scunthorpe, thence northwestwards along the said railway to a point opposite the northernmost corner of the Willows Estate, thence southwestwards to and along the northwestern boundary of the said estate and Whitgift School to the northeastern boundary of No 1, The Avenue, thence southeastwards along the said boundary to the rear boundary of No 1, The Avenue, thence southwestwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 2 to 7, The Avenue and in prolongation thereof to Great Coates Road, thence southeastwards along the said road to the River Freshney at Great Coates Bridge, thence southwestwards along the said river to the point of commencement.

GILBEY WARD

Commencing at the point at which the railway from Grimsby to Scunthorpe meets the eastern boundary of Great Coates Ward, thence northeastwards along the said boundary and continuing in prolongation of New Cut Drain to Pyewipe Road, thence southeastwards in a straight line passing through NG reference TA 26289 10500 to the rear boundary of No 11, Armstrong Place East, thence southwards along the said boundary and continuing southwards along the rear boundaries of Nos 10 to 1, Armstrong Place East and the eastern boundary of No 66, Armstrong Street, thence in a straight line

southwards to the western boundary of No 157, Corporation Road, thence southwards along the said boundary and continuing southwards in a straight line to the western boundary of No 148, Corporation Road, thence southwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 2b to 26, Jackson Street to the northern boundary of the Lodge, thence westwards along the said boundary to the path from the Tennis Courts to York Street, thence southeastwards along the said path to the path from York Street to Haycroft Street, thence southwestwards along the said path to Haycroft Street, thence southwestwards and northwestwards along the said street to a point opposite the western boundary of No 151, Haycroft Street, thence southwestward to and along the said boundary and in prolongation thereof to the railway, thence northwestwards along the said railway to the point of commencement.

ALEXANDRA WARD

Commencing at the southeastern corner of Gilbey Ward, on the railway line thence northeastwards, northwards and westwards along the eastern and northern boundaries of the said ward to and northeastwards along the eastern boundary of Great Coates Ward to low water, thence eastwards along the said low water to the outfall channel from the docks to the River Humber, thence southwestwards along the said outfall channel and continuing southwestwards in a straight line to the centre of Alexandra Dock which lies to the east of Alexandra Road, thence southwards through the said dock to Corporation Bridge, thence eastwards along the said bridge, Freeport Wharf and Market Street and in prolongation thereof to the railway, thence southwards and westwards along the said railway passing through Grimsby Town Station and continuing along said railway to the point of commencement.

VICTORIA WARD

Commencing at the point where Pasture Street meets the eastern boundary of Alexandra Ward, thence generally northwards along the said boundary and generally eastwards along low water to a point due north of the northeast corner of West Quay thence due south to said point and continuing southwards along the eastern boundary of said quay to and westwards along Wickham Road to and southwards along Humber Bank South to a point opposite the access path leading to the footbridge over the railway, thence southeastwards and southwestwards along the said access path and footbridge to Humber Street, thence southwestwards along the said street and Victor Street to Oxford Street, thence southeastwards along the said street to Wellsby Street, thence southwestwards along the said street to Wellington Street, thence northwestwards along the said street to and southwestwards along Convamore Road to Pasture Street, thence westwards along the said street to the point of commencement.

HUMBER WARD

Commencing at the point where Wellington Street meets the eastern boundary of Victoria Ward, thence generally northward along the said boundary and eastwards along Low Water to the eastern boundary of the Borough, thence southwestwards and following the Borough boundary to Wellington Street, thence northwestwards along the said street to the point of commencement.

WILLOWS WARD

Commencing at Great Coates Bridge on the eastern boundary of Great Coates Ward, thence northwestwards and following the said ward boundary to the southern boundary of Gilbey Ward, thence southeastwards along the said boundary to the River Freshney, thence southwestwards along the said river to the point of commencement.

CROMWELL WARD

Commencing at a point in Yarborough Road opposite the access road between Nos 148 and 150, Yarborough Road, thence northwestwards to and along the said access road to the rear boundary of No 148, Yarborough Road, thence northeastwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 146 to 58, Yarborough Road thence continuing in a straight line to the southeast corner of No 21 Wall Street thence northwestwards along the southern boundary of said property and southern boundary of No 26 Wall Street to and continuing along the rear boundaries of Nos 19 to 1 Balmoral Avenue crossing Spark Street to the northeastern boundary of the works in Spark Street, thence continuing northwestwards along the said boundary to the rear boundary of the garages situated behind Nos 5 to 19, Springway Crescent, thence northwestwards along the said boundary, the rear boundaries of the properties on the southwest side of Springway Crescent and the southwestern boundary of No 63, Springway Crescent, thence continuing northwestwards in a straight line from the westernmost corner of No 63, Springway Crescent, passing through NG reference TA 24800 09623 to the southeastern boundary of Willows Wards, thence northwards along the said boundary to the southern boundary of Gilbey Ward, thence southeastwards along the said boundary and the southern boundary of Alexandra Ward to Littlefield Lane, thence southwestwards and westwards along the said lane to Cross Coates Road, thence northwestwards along the said road to Yarborough Road and the point of commencement.

CENTRAL WARD

Commencing at the point at which Abbey Road meets Bargate, thence northwards along Bargate to Augusta Street, thence westwards along the said street to a point opposite the northwestern boundary of No 50, Augusta Street, thence northeastwards to and along the said boundary to the rear boundary of No 41, Canterbury Drive, thence northwestwards along the said

boundary, the rear boundaries of Nos 43 to 47, Canterbury Drive and the southwestern boundary of No 33, Westminster Drive to Westminster Drive, thence southwestwards along the said drive, to a point opposite the southwestern boundary of No 56 Westminster Drive thence northwestwards to and along said boundary and northeastwards along the rear boundary of said property to the rear boundary of No 19 Carlton Road thence northwestwards along said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 20-36 Carlton Road to the southern boundary of Cromwell Ward, thence northeastwards along the said boundary to the southern boundary of Alexandra Ward, thence eastwards along the said boundary and continuing eastwards and southeastwards along the railway from Grimsby to Louth to Welholme Road, thence westwards along the said road to Abbey Park Road thence northwestwards along said road to a point opposite the northern boundary of No 2 Abbey Park Road thence westwards to and along said boundary to the eastern boundary of No 16 Abbey Road thence southwards along said boundary to the rear boundary of said property thence southwestwards along said boundary and the rear boundary of No 18 Abbey Road and continuing in a straight line to the northern boundary of No 3 Welholme Avenue thence westwards along said boundary to Welholme Avenue thence southeastwards along said avenue to a point opposite the southern boundary of the property known as The Elms, thence southwestwards to and along said boundary and northwards along the western boundary of said property to Abbey Road thence southwestwards along said road to the point of commencement.

HAINTON WARD

Commencing at the point where Patrick Street meets the railway from Grimsby to Louth, thence northwestwards along the said railway and continuing northwestwards along the eastern boundary of Central Ward to the southeastern boundary of Alexandra Ward, thence northeastwards along the said boundary to the southern boundary of Victoria Ward,

thence eastwards along the said boundary to Ladysmith Road, thence southeastwards along the said road to the extension northeastward of Welhome Road to Ladysmith Road, thence in a straight line along the said extension and Welholme Road to a point opposite the eastern boundary of the Methodist Church, thence southeastwards to and along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 369 to 425, Convamore Road to Patrick Street, thence southwestwards along the said street to the point of commencement.

GRANT THOROLD WARD

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of Hainton Ward opposite the northern boundary of the factory to the west of Hardy Recreation Ground, thence northwestwards along the said ward boundary to the eastern boundary of Victoria Ward, thence northeastward and southeastward along the said boundary to the southern boundary of Humber Ward, thence continuing southeastwards along the said boundary to the eastern boundary of the Borough, thence southeastwards along the said boundary to Columbia Road, thence southwestwards along the said road to Weelsby Street South, thence southeastwards along Weelsby Street South to the northern boundary of Hardy Recreation Ground, thence southwestwards along the said boundary and the northern boundary of the factory to the west of the said recreation ground to the point of commencement.

CLEE WARD

Commencing at a point on the eastern boundary of the Borough at Love Lane Corner, thence northwestwards in a straight line to the unnamed stream running east of King George V Playing Field and Clee Fields, thence northwestwards along the said stream and continuing northwestwards in a straight line to Humberstone Road, thence northwestwards along the said road to a point opposite the northern boundary of Hardy Recreation Ground, thence southwestwards to and along the said boundary to the south east corner of Grant Thorold Ward, thence northwestwards and northeastwards along the

southern boundary of the said ward to the eastern boundary of the Borough, thence southeastwards and following the said boundary to the point of commencement.

WEST WARD

Commencing on the western boundary of the Borough at the southernmost corner of Great Coates Ward, thence northeastwards along the eastern boundary of the said ward to a point being in prolongation northwestwards of a line from the northwest corner of No 16a Broadway and passing through National Grid reference 23900 08705 thence southeastwards along said prolongation, the rear boundary of No 16a, Broadway, and the rear boundaries of Nos 16 to 2, Broadway and the northern boundary of No 66, Little Coates Road, to Little Coates Road, thence southwestwards along the said road to Laceby Road thence eastwards along said road to a point opposite the eastern boundary of No 427 Laceby Road thence southwards to and along said boundary and the eastern boundary of No 5 Stephen Crescent and continuing southwards in a straight line to the eastern boundary of No 7 Stephen Crescent thence southwards along said boundary to the northern boundary of Bradley Recreation Ground thence westwards along said boundary, crossing Bradley Road to the western boundary of the Borough thence northwards, westwards and generally northwards following the western boundary of the Borough to the point of commencement.

LITTLE COATES WARD

Commencing at the northeastern corner of West Ward, in Little Coates Road thence northwestwards along the northern boundary of the said ward to the eastern boundary of Great Coates Ward, thence northeastwards along the said boundary and the eastern boundary of Willows Ward to the southwestern boundary of Cromwell Ward, thence generally southeastwards along the said boundary to Littlefield Lane, thence southwestwards along the said lane

and the access road from Littlefield Lane to the Water Works and continuing southwestwards in prolongation of said access road to the southern boundary of the Water Works thence northwestward along said southern boundary to NG reference TA 25117 08550, thence southwards in a straight line to the northwestern corner of No 76, Cambridge Road, thence continuing southwards along the western boundary of No 76, Cambridge Road to Cambridge Road, thence westwards along the said road to Little Coates Road, thence southwestwards along the said road to the point of commencement.

CARNFORTH WARD

Commencing at the point at which Laceby Road meets the eastern boundary of West Ward, opposite Brocklesby Road thence westwards and northwards along the said boundary to the southern boundary of Little Coates Ward, thence northeastward and following the said boundary to the southern boundary of Cromwell Ward, thence eastward along the said boundary to the western boundary of the Sports Ground, thence southwards along the said boundary to the southwestern corner of the said sports ground, thence westwards to the western boundary of the cricket ground, thence southwards along the said boundary and continuing in a straight line to the drain at NG reference TA 25749 08643 thence southwards along the said drain and in prolongation thereof to Ely Road, thence westwards along the said road to Chelmsford Avenue, thence southwards along the said avenue to Carnforth Crescent, thence southwestwards along the said crescent to Worcester Avenue, thence southwards along the said avenue to Laceby Road, thence westwards along the said road to the point of commencement.

NUNSTHORPE WARD

Commencing at the southeastern corner of Carnforth Ward, at the junction of Laceby Road and Worcester Avenue thence northward and following the eastern boundary of the said ward to and continuing southeastward along

along Ely Road to Hereford Avenue, thence southeastward along the said
 avenue to Lacey Road, thence westwards along the said road to Second Avenue,
 thence southeastwards along the said avenue to a point opposite the southern
 boundary of No 136, Second Avenue, thence westwards to and along the said
 boundary to the rear boundary of No 56, Redbourne Road, thence westward
 along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 54 to 32, Redbourne
 Road to the rear boundary of No 5, Winthorpe Road, thence southwards along
 the said boundary, the rear boundaries of Nos 7 to 57, Winthorpe Road and
 the eastern boundary of No 2, Crosby Road and continuing southward in a
 straight line to the eastern boundary of No 1, Crosby Road, thence south-
 wards along the said boundary to the rear boundary of No 1, Crosby Road,
 thence westwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 3
 to 51, Crosby Road, thence northwards along the western boundary of No 51,
 Crosby Road, crossing Crosby Road to a point in Wainfleet Road opposite the
 prolongation southwestwards of the common boundary between No 15, Wainfleet
 Road and No 48, Crosby Road, thence northeastwards along the said prolongation
 and common boundary to the rear boundary of No 15, Wainfleet Road, thence
 northwards along the said boundary to the southern boundary of No 13,
 Wainfleet Road, thence eastwards along the said boundary to the rear boundary
 of No 13, Wainfleet Road, thence northwards along the rear boundaries of
 Nos 13 to 9, Wainfleet Road to the rear boundary of No 41, Caistor Drive,
 thence northeastwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of
 Nos 39 & 37, Caistor Drive to the common boundary between No 37, Caistor
 Drive and No 43, Cabourne Road, thence northwestwards along the said common
 boundary and in prolongation thereof to Cabourne Road, thence northwestwards
 along the said road to Caistor Drive, thence northeastwards along the
 said drive to a point opposite the northern boundary of No 40, Caistor
 Drive, thence westwards to and along the said boundary to the rear
 boundary of No 204, Winchester Avenue, thence northwards along

the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 206 to 210, Winchester Avenue to the western boundary of No 2, Redbourne Road, thence northwards along the said boundary to Redbourne Road, thence westwards along the said road to Winchester Avenue, thence northwards along the said avenue to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 230 and 232, Winchester Avenue, thence eastwards to and along the said boundary to the rear boundary of No 232, Winchester Avenue, thence northwards along the said boundary and the rear boundary of No 234, Winchester Avenue to Torksey Drive, thence eastwards along the said drive to a point opposite the common boundary between Nos 3 and 5, Torksey Drive, thence northwards to and along the said boundary to the rear boundary of No 3, Torksey Drive, thence westwards along the said boundary to the western boundary of No 3, Torksey Drive, thence southwards along the said boundary to the common boundary of No 1, Torksey Drive and No 236, Winchester Avenue, thence southwestwards along the said boundary and in prolongation thereof to Winchester Avenue, thence southwards along the said avenue to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos 251 and 253, Winchester Avenue, thence generally westward to and along the said common boundary to the boundary of the Corporation Yard, thence southwards and westwards along the eastern and southern boundaries of the said Yard to Burwell Drive, thence northwards along the said drive to a point opposite the northern boundary of Nunsthorpe Community Centre, thence westwards to and along the said boundary and in prolongation thereof to the eastern boundary of the Library, thence northwards along the said boundary and westwards along the northern boundary of the said Library to the access road to the rear of Nos 170 to 184, Sutcliffe Avenue, thence continuing westwards along the said access road to the rear boundary of No 186, Sutcliffe Avenue, thence westwards along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of No 188, Sutcliffe Avenue and Nunsthorpe Tavern to Langton Drive, thence northwards along the said drive to a point opposite the southern boundary of No 4, Langton Drive, thence westwards to and along the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 196 to 206, Sutcliffe Avenue to the common

boundaries of No 206 Sutcliffe Avenue and No 71, Winchester Avenue, thence northwards and following the said common boundary to Sutcliffe Avenue, thence northwards in a straight line crossing Sutcliffe Avenue to the rear boundary of No 69, Winchester Avenue, thence northwards and following the said boundary and the rear boundaries of Nos 67 to 1, Winchester Avenue to the northern boundary of No 1, Winchester Avenue, thence westwards along the said boundary to Winchester Avenue, thence northwards along the said avenue to Laceby Road being the point of commencement.

WELLOW WARD

WELLSBY WARD

Commencing at the point where the eastern boundary of the Borough meets the

Commencing at a point where the southwestern boundary of the Borough meets the southeastern boundary of Pelham Ward, thence northeastwards along the southeastern boundary of the said ward to Waltham Road, thence southwards along the said road and Grimsby Road to a point opposite the southern boundary of the Borough being NG reference TA 26549 05031, thence northeastwards in a straight line to the southern boundary of the Borough, thence southwards and following the Borough boundary to the point of commencement.

SCARTHO WARD

Commencing at a point where the southern boundary of the Borough meets the eastern boundary of Springfield Ward, thence southwestward and northwards along the said ward boundary and the eastern boundary of Pelham Ward to the southern boundary of Wintringham Ward, thence northwards and eastwards along the said boundary to the western boundary of Weelsby Ward, thence southeastwards along the said boundary to the eastern boundary of the Borough, thence southwestwards and following the eastern and southern boundaries of the Borough to the point of commencement.
