**Electoral Review of South Norfolk.**

At the Parish Council meeting held on Tuesday 12 July 2016 the matter of the Electoral Review of South Norfolk was discussed by members. It was resolved to recommend that existing electoral arrangements for Easton ward, of which Marlingford and Colton Parish is a part, remain unchanged following the review.

Easton ward comprises the parishes of Easton, Marlingford and Colton, Barford with Wramplingham and Great Melton and the reasons for our recommendation are the links we have with the other parishes in the ward, which are:

- With **Easton** through shared concerns about traffic and drainage, being in the same benefice, use of allotments, a gymnasium and post office.
- With **Barford and Wramplingham**, our parish being in the same school catchment area of Barford primary and Wymondham High.
- With **Great Melton** through the Great Melton Estate covering both Marlingford and Great Melton with a permissive footpath network running through both villages.

We hope our recommendation will be accepted by the Boundary Commission and would ask that this letter is treated as our formal response to the consultation on the Electoral review.
