It is clear that the proposal to link the parishes of Houghton & Wyton, Wyton on the Hill and Hemingford Grey is the result of a 'desk-top decision.' There is no practical or cohesive geographical logic to the proposition.

Hemingford, Abbots, Hemingford Grey and Houghton & Wyton share and are bound together with common environmental, development, social, economic and community agendas which need a shared political representative to give leadership to address the concerns and opportunities of this community.

To the 'desk-top' analyst the Ouse Valley/Meadows must appear to divide the Hemingfords from Houghton & Wyton. In reality the geography of this proposed Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty unites the three parishes and has integrated the communities for the reasons stated above.

It is fair to state that Hilton within the current boundary has little practical logic only numerical expediency. The proposal to add Wyton on the Hill would fall into the same category.
