PROPOSALS FOR REVISED ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE BOROUGH
OF WEYMOUTH AND PORTLAND IN THE COUNTY OF DORSET

1. We, the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, having carried out our initial review of the electoral arrangements for the Borough of Weymouth and Portland in accordance with the requirements of section 63 of, and Schedule 9 to, the Local Government Act 1972, present our proposals for the future electoral arrangements for that borough.
2. In accordance with the procedure laid down in section 60(1) and (2) of the 1972 Act, notice was given on 31 December 1974 that we were to undertake this review. This was incorporated in a consultation letter addressed to the Weymouth and Portland Borough Council, copies of which were circulated to the Dorset County Council, the Parish Council in the district, the Member of Parliament for the constituency concerned and the headquarters of the main political parties. Copies were also sent to the editors of local newspapers circulating in the area and of the local government press. Notices inserted in the local press announced the start of the review and invited comments from members of the public and from any interested bodies.
3. Weymouth and Portland Borough Council were invited to prepare a draft scheme of representation for our consideration. In doing so, they were asked to observe the rules laid down in Schedule 11 to the Local Government Act 1972 and the guidelines which we set out in our Report No 6 about the proposed size of the Council and the proposed number of councillors for each ward. They were asked also to take into account any views expressed to them following their consultation with local interests. We therefore asked that they should publish details of their provisional proposals about a month before they submitted their draft scheme to us, thus allowing an opportunity for local comment.

4. In accordance with section 7(4)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972 the Council exercised an option for a system of elections by thirds.

5. On 28 May 1975 Weymouth and Portland Borough Council presented their draft scheme of representation. The Council proposed to divide the area into 13 wards each returning 3 councillors to form a council of 39 members.

6. Despite publicity in the local newspapers the draft scheme received no comment. We considered the draft scheme but noted that the standard of equality of representation was uneven, particularly with regard to the parish of Portland, which was substantially over-represented compared with the rest of the district. We were also of the opinion that for a district of this size and character and in the absence of any compelling reasons to the contrary, a council of 39 members would be too large. Further, the division of the district into 13 three-member wards would not be compatible with future county electoral arrangements. For these reasons we found the draft scheme unacceptable and decided to refer it back to the Borough Council with a request that it should be redrawn to secure greater equality of representation, a smaller council and compatibility with county electoral arrangements.

7. On 1 October 1976 the Weymouth and Portland Borough Council submitted a revised draft scheme in which they proposed to divide the district into 14 wards each returning two or three members to form a council of 35 members. The Borough Council had published details of their revised proposals about a month earlier and invited comments upon them.

8. The comments included representations from a local political association about the proposed Radipole ward. A local borough councillor wrote suggesting a minor modification to the boundary between the proposed Weymouth East and Weymouth West wards. Another borough councillor, also a member of Portland Town Council, objected to the revised draft scheme insofar as it would influence the future county electoral divisions for the parish of Portland. One other local

councillor suggested an alternative scheme comprising 14 two-member wards to form a total council of 28.

9. We considered the revised draft scheme together with the comments which had been made. The Weymouth and Portland Borough Council's revised scheme met our objections to their original scheme in that it offered both a good standard of equality of representation and potential compatibility. We decided therefore to adopt their revised draft scheme as our draft proposals subject to minor modifications recommended by the Ordnance Survey in the interest of good boundaries.

10. We issued our draft proposals on 11 February 1977 and these were sent to all who had received our consultation letter or who had commented on the Council's draft schemes. The Council were asked to make these draft proposals, and the accompanying map which defined the proposed ward boundaries, available for inspection at their main offices. Representations on our draft proposals were invited from those to whom they were circulated, and, by public notices, from other members of the public and interested bodies. We asked that comments should reach us by 15 April 1977.

11. The Weymouth and Portland Borough Council suggested a number of minor amendments to the description of the proposed ward boundaries which had been included with our draft proposals. We noted that these suggestions had been discussed with Ordnance Survey who had accepted them in part, and that a revised ward description had been prepared. The Dorset County Council confirmed that our draft proposals would be compatible with their proposed number of county electoral divisions. The local political party which had previously commented on the draft scheme wrote again reiterating its objections to the proposed Radipole ward but offered no satisfactory alternative which would comply with the statutory requirement for equality of representation.

12. We reviewed our draft proposals in the light of the comments which we had received and resolved that they should be confirmed subject to the minor changes in boundary descriptions mentioned in paragraph 11. We formulated our final proposals accordingly.

13. Details of these final proposals are set out in Schedules 1 and 2 to this report and on the attached map. Schedule 1 gives the names of the wards and the number of councillors to be returned by each. Schedule 2 shows our proposals for the order of retirement of councillors. The boundaries of the proposed new wards are defined on the map.

PUBLICATION

17. In accordance with Section 60(5)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972 a copy of this report and a copy of the map are being sent to Weymouth and Portland Borough Council and will be available for public inspection at the Council's main offices. Copies of this report without the map are also being sent to those who received the consultation letter and to those who made comments. A detailed description of the boundaries of the proposed wards, as defined on the map, is set out in Schedule 3 to this Report.

NORTH WARD

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of the Borough meets the rear boundaries of the proposed property development on the eastern side of Jordan Way, thence southwards along said boundaries to and westwards along Littlemoor Road to a point opposite the western boundary of No 485 Littlemoor Road thence generally southwestwards to and along said boundary and the southeastern boundary of Broadway Close housing estate and in prolongation thereof to the Waterloo-Weymouth railway, thence southwards along said railway to a point opposite the southern boundary of the Broadway County Secondary School, thence generally southwestwards to and along said southern boundary and the unnamed track running along the southern boundary of the School to Dorchester Road, thence southwards along said road to a point opposite the southern boundary of No 425 Dorchester Road, thence westwards to and along said southern boundary to the western boundary of said property thence northwards along said western boundary and the western boundaries of Nos 429 to 483 Dorchester Road, to the northwestern-most corner of the last mentioned property, thence northwestwards in a straight line, crossing Nottingham Lane to the eastern boundary of Parcel No 5577 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6682 Edition of 1956, thence northwestwards along said eastern boundary and continuing northwestwards along the eastern boundary of Parcel No 5684 to the River Wey, thence northwards along said river to the drain running between the River Wey and the Bridleway, leading from the road known as Littlemead, thence westwards along said drain to said bridleway, thence westwards along said bridleway to the northern boundary of Parcel No 9024 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 64-6583 Edition of 1959, thence westwards along said northern boundary and continuing westwards along the northern boundaries of Parcel Nos 7618 and 6522 to the western boundary of the Borough, thence

generally northwards, westwards and northwards along said western boundary and generally southeastwards, southwards and eastwards along the northern boundary of the borough to the point of commencement.

NORTH CENTRAL WARD

Commencing at the point where the western boundary of the Borough meets the southern boundary of North Ward, thence generally eastwards, southwards, eastwards, northwards and northeastwards along said southern boundary to the northern boundary of the borough, thence southeastwards along said northern boundary to the eastern boundary of the GVC, thence southwards along the said eastern boundary and generally westwards along the southern boundary of the aforesaid property to the access road leading to the said GVC, thence southwards along said road adjacent to the eastern boundary of Parcel No 0103 on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6983 Edition of 1959, thence southwards along said prolongation and track to Littlemoor Road, thence westwards along said road to the southeastern boundary of Parcel No 5979 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6882, Edition of 1958, Reprinted 1976, thence southwards along said southeastern boundary and continuing southwestwards along the southeastern boundary of Parcel No 4962 to the southwestern boundary of the last mentioned parcel, thence northwestward along said southwestern boundary to the eastern boundary of Parcel No 2753, thence southwards along said western boundary of said parcel thence northwards along said boundary to the footpath that runs from Littlemoor Road, south of Littlemoor County Primary School, to Two Mile Ceppice, thence generally southwestwards along said footpath to the northeastern corner of Parcel No 8825 thence southwestwards along said northwestern boundary and the northwestern boundary of Parcel No 7717 to the southwestern boundary of the last mentioned parcel, thence southeastwards along said southwestern boundary and continuing along the southwestern boundary of Parcel No 8505 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6782 Edition of 1956 and the southwestern boundary of Parcel No 8994 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6781 edition of 1957 to National

Grid reference SY 6787181849, thence due south from said point to the westernmost corner of Parcel No 9579, thence southeastwards along the southwestern boundary of said parcel to National Grid reference SY 6799681643, thence southwestwards in a straight line to the northern most corner of No 29 Hetherly Road, thence southwestwards along the northwestern boundaries of Nos 29 to 1 in said road and continuing southwestwards along the northwestern boundary of No 186A Dorchester Road to Dorchester Road, thence southeastwards along said road to Spa Road, thence westwards along said road to the Waterloo to Weymouth railway, thence southwards along said railway to a point being the prolongation southeastwards of the footpath running at the rear of the properties on the southern side of Coronation Road, thence northwestwards along said prolongation and footpath to National Grid reference SY 6734880963, thence westwards from said reference point in a straight line to Radipole Park Drive, at a point being in prolongation of the stream being Parcel No 0993 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY. 6780 Edition of 1957, thence generally westwards along said stream to the main course of the River Wey, thence northwestwards along said river to a point due east of the easternmost corner of Parcel No 5715 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6681 Edition of 1956, thence due west to said eastern corner, thence northwestwards and westwards along the northeastern and northern boundaries of Parcel No 5715 the southern boundary of Parcel No 4622, and the southern boundary of Parcel No 3623 to Radipole Lane, thence northeastwards along said lane to the lane known locally as Coldharbour Lane, thence westwards along said lane to a point opposite the southeastern boundary of the property known as Causeway Cottage, thence southwestwards to and along said southeastern boundary to the southern boundary of said property, thence westwards along said southern boundary and the southern boundary of the property known as Causeway Bungalow to the western boundary of the last mentioned property, thence northwards along said western boundary to the northern boundary of Parcel No 0333 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6681 Edition of

1956, thence generally northwestwards along said northern boundary and the northern boundary of Parcel No 0033, as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6581 Edition of 1958 to the western boundary of the Borough, thence generally northwards along said borough boundary to the point of commencement.

PRESTON WARD

Commencing at the point where the eastern boundary of North Central Ward meets the northern boundary of the Borough, thence generally eastwards, northeastwards, southwards and southwestwards along the northern and eastern boundaries of the Borough to a point being in prolongation southeastwards of the drain on the northeastern boundary of Parcel No 6780, as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6880 Edition of 1957, thence northwestwards along said prolongation and drain and continuing northwestwards along the southwestern boundary of Parcel No 3345 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plan SY 6881 Edition of 1957 to the rear of the properties Nos 9 to 1 Moorside Avenue, thence northwestwards along said rear boundaries and continuing northwestwards crossing the eastern end of Weymouth Bay Avenue to the northeastern boundary of No 109 Weymouth Bay Avenue, thence northwestwards along said northeastern boundary and continuing northwestwards along the drain forming the northeastern boundary of Parcel Nos 0641, 0255, 0157 and 7772 as shown on Ordnance Survey 1:2500 Plans SY 6881 and SY 6781 Editions of 1957 to the eastern boundary of North Central Ward, thence northwestwards and generally northeastwards along said eastern boundary to the point of commencement.

RADIPOLE WARD

Commencing at the point where the southwestern boundary of Preston Ward meets the eastern boundary of the Borough, being Mean Low Water, thence southwestwards along said borough boundary to a point being in prolongation southeastwards of the northeastern boundary of No 62 Greenhill,

thence northwestwards along said prolongation, crossing The Esplanade and continuing northwestwards along said northeastern boundary to the road known as Greenhill, thence southwestwards along said road to a point opposite the northern boundary of Rowland Court, thence generally northwestwards and southwestwards to and along said northern boundary and continuing southwestwards along the rear boundaries Nos 31 to 25, Melcombe Avenue crossing the access road to the Lodmoor Car Park, and continuing along the rear of the properties Nos 15 to 12 Cranford Avenue to the eastern boundary of No 11 Cranford Avenue, thence northeastwards along said eastern boundary and in prolongation thereof to the southwestern boundary of the Weymouth College Tennis Courts, thence northwestwards along said southwestern boundary and in prolongation thereof to Lynmoor Road, thence southwestwards along said road and continuing along Cranford Avenue and Fernhill Avenue to Dorchester Road, thence southeastwards along said road to Carlton Road North, thence southwestwards along said road to Glendinning Avenue, thence southeastwards along said avenue to a point opposite the northern boundary of No 1 Glendinning Avenue, thence southwestwards and southwards along the northern and western boundary of said property to Carlton Road South, thence westwards along said road to the footpath running between the properties known as St Michael and Swanhurst in said road, thence southwestwards along said footpath to Cassiobury Road, thence due west to Radipole Park Drive, thence northwestwards along said drive to the southern boundary of North Central Ward, thence generally northeastwards along said southern boundary to the southwestern boundary of Preston Ward, thence southeastwards along said southwestern boundary to the point of commencement.

WESTHAM NORTH WARD

Commencing at the point where the western boundary of the Borough meets the southern boundary of North Central Ward, thence generally southeastwards along said southern boundary to the western boundary of Radipole Ward,

thence southeastwards along said western boundary to its intersection with the southern boundary of said ward being National Grid reference SY 6761579995, thence southwestwards in a straight line to National Grid reference SY 6728479720 being a point on the track adjacent to the northwestern boundary of the South Dorset Technical College, thence southwestwards along said track to a point opposite the southwestern boundary of the Technical College, thence southeastwards to and along said southwestern boundary and continuing southeastwards along the rear of the properties Nos 192 to 154 Newstead Road to the southern boundary of the last mentioned property, thence westwards along said southern boundary to Newstead Road, thence southeastwards along said road to Milton Road, thence southwestwards along said road to the eastern boundary of No 8 Holyrood Terrace, thence southeastwards along said eastern boundary to the southern boundary of said property, thence westwards along said southern boundary to the road known as Holyrood Terrace, thence westwards along said road, crossing Holly Road to the rear of the properties Nos 72 to 98 Abbotsbury Road, thence westwards along said rear boundaries to the eastern boundary of No 14 Cromwell Road, thence northwards along said eastern boundary and the eastern boundary of Nos 16 to 42 Cromwell Road to the footpath between No 42 and 44 Cromwell Road, thence westwards along said footpath to Cromwell Road, thence northwards along said road to Longcroft Road, thence northeastwards along said road to a point opposite the northeastern boundary of the Westham County Modern School, thence northwestwards, southwestwards and southeastwards to and along said northeastern, northwestern and southwestern boundary of said school, to the southern boundary of No 22 Links Road, thence westwards along said southern boundary to Links Road, thence southwards along said road to a point opposite the northwestern boundary of No 21 Links Road, thence southwestwards to and along said northwestern boundary and continuing southwestwards along the northwestern boundaries of No 3 and 4 Rutland Road, Nos 107 to 91 Kitchener Road and No 28 Queensland Road, crossing Queensland Road to the northwestern boundary of No 37 Queensland Road, thence

southwestwards along said northwestern boundary and the northwestern boundary of Nos 89 to 81 Kitchener Road, to the western boundary of the last mentioned property, thence southeastwards along said western boundary, crossing Kitchener Road to Sydney Street, thence southeastwards along said street to Adelaide Crescent, thence southeastwards along said crescent to Corporation Road, thence southwestwards along said road to Perth Street, thence southeastwards along said street to Abbotsbury Road, thence westwards along said road to Southview Road, thence southeastwards along said road to a point opposite the rear of the properties Nos 175 to 185 Abbotsbury Road, thence southwestwards to and along said rear boundaries to the northern boundary of the Playing Field, thence northwestwards and southwestwards along said northern boundary to the western boundary of No 207 Abbotsbury Road, thence northwestwards along said western boundary and in prolongation thereof to Abbotsbury Road, thence southwestwards along said road to a point opposite the northeastern boundary of No 208 Abbotsbury Road, thence northwestwards to and along said northeastern boundary and continuing northwestwards along the northeastern boundaries of No 2 and 6 to 60 Shirecroft Road, to Shirecroft Road, thence westwards along said road to a point opposite the eastern boundary of No 71 Shirecroft Road, thence northwestwards to and along said eastern boundary to the northwestern boundary of said property, thence southwestwards along said northwestern boundary and the northwestern boundary of Nos 69 to 61 Shirecroft Road, crossing the footpath running between Shirecroft Road to Cornwall Close, to the northern boundary of the Crematorium and Nursery, attached thereto thence southwestwards along said northern boundary, crossing Norfolk Road to the northeastern boundary of the Playing Fields of the Westhaven County Primary School, thence northwestwards along said northeastern boundary to National Grid reference SY 6618879336, thence westwards in a straight line to the eastern most corner of No 461 Radipole Lane, thence southwestwards along the southeastern boundary of said property to Radipole Lane, thence southwards along said lane to a point

opposite the fence to the rear of the properties on the western side of said lane also being in prolongation northeastwards of the rear of the properties Nos 40 to 68 Granby Close, thence southwestwards to and along said fence to the western boundary of the Borough, thence generally northwards along said western boundary to the point of commencement.

MELCOMBE REGIS WARD

Commencing at the point where the southeastern boundary of Radipole Ward meets the eastern boundary of the Borough, being Mean Low Water, thence southwestwards and southeastwards along said borough boundary to Weymouth Harbour, thence westwards and northwards along said harbour to Westham Bridge, being part of Westham Road, thence eastwards along said road to the road known as Radipole Park Drive, thence generally northwards along said road to the southeastern boundary of Radipole Ward, thence generally northeastwards along said southeastern boundary to the point of commencement.

WESTHAM EAST WARD

Commencing at the point where the southern boundary of Westham North Ward meets the western boundary of Melcombe Regis Ward, thence generally southwards along said western boundary to a point being due northeastwards from the eastern end of Weston Road, thence due southwestwards to Weston Road, thence southwestwards and westwards along said road, crossing Marsh Road and the former Weymouth to Portland Railway to a point opposite the northern boundary of No 30 Chickerell Road, thence westwards to and along said northern boundary and the northern boundaries of Nos 32 to 56 Chickerell Road to the southern boundary of the Weymouth Athletics Centre and Playing Fields complex, thence northwestwards and generally westwards along said southern boundary and generally northwards along the western boundary of said Athletics Centre and Playing Fields complex to the northwesternmost corner of the centre, and in prolongation of said western boundary to the

rear boundary of No 211 Abbotsbury Road thence northeastwards along said boundary and the rear boundary of No 209 in said road to the southern boundary of Westham North Ward, thence generally northeastwards along said southern boundary to the point of commencement.

WEYMOUTH EAST WARD

Commencing at the point where the southern boundary of Melcombe Regis Ward meets the eastern boundary of the Borough at the entrance to Weymouth Harbour thence generally southwestwards along said borough boundary including the Portland Breakwater known as Bincleaves Groyne, to a point due eastwards of the intersection of the footpath from Ryland's Lane to the foreshore with the dismantled Weymouth-Portland railway thence due westwards in a straight line to said intersection thence northeastwards along said dismantled railway to National Grid reference SY 6725077310, thence due east from said point to Old Castle Road, thence northeastwards along said road and Rodwell Road to Wyke Road, thence southwestwards along Wyke Road to a point opposite the eastern boundary of No 2A Wyke Road, thence northwards along said eastern boundary to the northern boundary of said property, thence westwards along the northern boundaries of Nos 2A to 2D Wyke Road and continuing westwards along the southern boundary of No 12A Glen Avenue to the access road leading from Glen Avenue to Gypsy Lane, thence westwards along said access road to Gypsy Lane, thence northwards and westwards along said lane to Ashton Road, thence northwards along said road, crossing Chickerell Road to the western boundary of the St Martins Hall, thence northwards along said western boundary to the southern boundary of Westham East Ward, thence generally eastwards along said southern boundary and the southern boundary of Melcombe Regis Ward, to the point of commencement.

WEYMOUTH WEST WARD

Commencing at the point where the southern boundary of Westham East Ward
