### **ELECTORAL REVIEW OF BROXTOWE: FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS**

The Commission publishes its final recommendations on the future electoral arrangements for Broxtowe Borough Council today. The report and an interactive map of the final recommendations are available in the LGBCE consultation area, <http://consultation.lgbce.org.uk>. We have also arranged with your officers for hard copies of the report to be sent to the Council.

We have informed the national headquarters of the main political parties, MPs and MEPs with constituency interests in the area, all parish and town councils, the police and crime commissioner for Nottinghamshire and all respondents.

The Commission has now completed its review of Broxtowe. The changes proposed must now be implemented by order subject to Parliamentary scrutiny. A draft Order – the legal document which brings into force the recommendations – will be laid in Parliament. The draft Order will provide for new electoral arrangements for Broxtowe to be implemented at the local elections in 2015.
