This is going to create a lot of confusion for voters and candidates alike, especially with the changes to the District Council boundaries that you're proposing.

Residents in Hinchingsbrooke Park will still be part of the town for the county council and town council elections but be part of Brampton village for the district council elections. They will be paying a different precept since towns precept higher than villages and this will cause resentment.

You're also having smaller wards for the town council to give them more sense of identity but lumping Hinchingsbrooke with a village to which it has little in common.

I've represented Huntingdon West ward for 17 years on both District and Town. I would urge you not to make this mistake.

Dear All

I am re-sending the attached documents concerning the recommendation from the Local Government Boundary Commission concerning the recommended changes to both District and Town Wards.

For the Town Council, the number of Councillors remain the same, however the wards are changed from three wards to 8 wards, as follows:

East; South; South West; Central; North East; West; Stukeley Meadows & Hinchingsbrooke Park

On the District Wards : the town will be split as follows :

East Ward ; Two Members – made up of East and South town wards

North East Ward ; Three Members – made up of North East, West, Central and South West town wards

Stukeley Meadows town ward, becomes part of The Stukeley district ward; Three Members

Hinchingbrooke Park town ward becomes part of Brampton district ward; Two Members.

Reminder: the consultation closes on 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2016
