Dear Sir, please could you consider moving those of us who live in Chorlton-cum-Hardy (and have an M21 postcode) from the Whalley Range Ward to the Chorlton Ward? As many bodies use Ward boundaries when reporting/administering things we are often defined as living in Whalley Range rather than Chorlton-cum-Hardy. It is really confusing for everyone. Also we do not feel like we are being represented correctly by our councilors. They are very much concentrated on issues effecting Whalley Range and we get left out. The Chorlton and Chorlton Park councilors will not do anything for us because we are in the Whalley Range Ward. We very much feel separated from the other people we live along side day by day. in 2002 the Electoral Register for the Whalley Range ward had 6693 properties, 1553 of which have an M21 postcode. The electorate of the Whalley Range ward is 11647 and 3201 electors are registered at the 1553 properties in the M21 postcode. As you can see from the above approx. 25% of the ward is made up of residents in Chorlton-cum-Hardy Alternatively, perhaps you could rename the Ward to 'Whalley Range and Chorlton East'? I did a survey some years ago which I forwarded to my local councilor asking how people felt about this. Over 98% of people surveyed said they felt it was important that their true location was recognized correctly by the council, emergency services etc. kind regards
