

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Warrington Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance)(Cuerdley) Order 2014

Made this 1st April 2014

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

The Council of the Borough of Warrington (“the council”), in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 (“the 2007 Act”), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated December 2013.

The council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with the local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The council in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section:

The council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 86, 98(3) and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Warrington Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance)(Cuerdley) Order 2014
- (2) It shall come into force on 1st April 2014.

Interpretation

2. In this Order

“borough” means the borough of Warrington Borough Council

“map” means the map marked “Map referred to in the Warrington Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance)(Cuerdley) Order 2014” and deposited in accordance section 96(4) of the 2007 Act;

“registration officer” means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

Effect of the Order

3. This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to the provision of this Order.

Dissolution of parish council for the parish of Cuerdley

4. The Parish Council for the parish of Cuerdley shall be dissolved.

Parish Meeting of the Parish area

5. (1) a parish meeting be created for the parish area of Cuerdley as shown on the map.

(2) The name of the parish meeting shall be Cuerdley Parish Meeting.

Annual Meeting of Parish Meeting

6. The first annual meeting of Cuerdley Parish Meeting in 2014 shall be convened by the Chief Executive of Warrington Borough Council. The meeting shall take place between 1 March and 1 June 2014.

Transfer of Assets

7. The assets described in Schedule 1 shall transfer from the Cuerdley Parish Council to the Cuerdley Parish Meeting on the date specified in column (2) of Schedule 1.

Electoral Register

8. The registration officer for Warrington Borough Council shall make such rearrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

Order Date

9. 1st April 2014 is the date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils)(England) Regulations 2008.

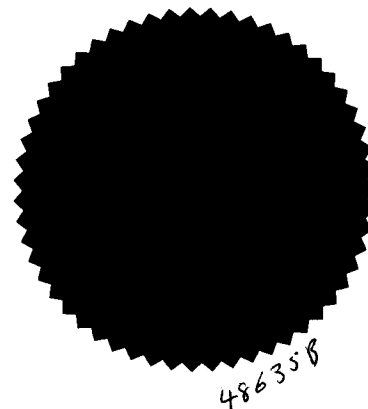

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Warrington Borough Council for the dissolution of Cuerdley Parish Council and the creation of Cuerdley Parish Meeting.

Article 6 provides for the Chief Executive of Warrington Borough Council to convene the first annual meeting of Cuerdley Parish Meeting between 1st March and 1st June 2014.

Article 7 provides for the all funds and balances to be transferred to from Cuerdley Parish Council to Cuerdley Parish Meeting.

Article 8 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new arrangements.

The map defined in Article 2 shows the general outline of the parish of Cuerdley. A more detailed version of the map is available for inspection (along with copies of this Order), at all reasonable times at the offices of Warrington Borough Council.
