wish to wholeheartedly support, the recent draft recommendations, for new electoral arrangements, for the Crawley area of West Sussex, from the Local Government Boundary Commission.

We are aware that three Crawley County Councillors have submitted an alternative proposal, which we are totally opposed to.

In our opinion, the Boundary Commission's proposals make minimal changes to the status quo and cause the least disruption, to traditional voting arrangements, in our town and therefore the least confusion for our residents.

Crawley's residents have always closely identified with their local neighbourhoods and are well aware of the natural boundaries provided by railway lines, roads and rivers, in the town.
