ELECTORAL REVIEW OF SHEPWAY: FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commission publishes its final recommendations on the future electoral arrangements for Shepway District Council today. We have informed MPs and MEPs with constituency interests in the area, all parish and town councils, the police and crime commissioner for Kent and all respondents.


The Commission has now completed its review of Shepway. The changes proposed must now be implemented by order subject to Parliamentary scrutiny. A draft Order – the legal document which brings into force the recommendations – will be laid in Parliament. The draft Order will provide for new electoral arrangements for Shepway to be implemented at the local elections in 2015.
