PART A

ORDERS MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT UNDER PART IV OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972.

The following Orders in this section alter the boundaries of counties, districts, London boroughs and parishes. A few additionally abolish or create parishes. Some of the Orders came into effect on 1 April 1994. Others, although made in this period, will not be effective until 1 April 1995. The effective date of each Order is given at the end of the entry.

BEDFORDSHIRE

The Mid-Bedfordshire (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/3243)

This order makes changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Shefford, Campton and Chicksands, Meppershall and Southill. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

BERKSHIRE

The Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Surrey (County Boundaries) Order 1994 (SI 1994/390).

This order transfers areas from Buckinghamshire and from Surrey to Berkshire to create a new parish of Colnbrook with Poyle. In approximate terms an area of 520 hectares is being transferred. The population affected totals 3,160. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

CAMBRIDGESHIRE

The Fenland (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2910)

This order creates a new parish of Gorefield from part of the parish of Leverington. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

CHESHIRE

The Warrington (Parishes) Order 1994 (SI 1994/557)

This order creates a new parish of Birchwood. It also makes adjustments to sixteen parish boundaries and the boundary of an unparished area. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

DERBYSHIRE

The Chesterfield (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2329)

This order transfers land between the parishes of Brimington and Staveley and unparished areas. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

DURHAM

The Durham and Tyne and Wear (County and District Boundaries) (Variation) Order 1993/3129.

This Order varies supplementary provisions made in the Durham and Tyne and Wear (County and District Boundaries) Order 1992 (SI 1992/3054). The effect is to vary the metropolitan borough ward to which two minor areas are transferred. The effective date of this order is 1 April 1994.

EAST HAMPSHIRE

The East Hampshire (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2713)

This order creates a new parish of Stroud from parts of the parishes of Petersfield and Langrish. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

EAST SUSSEX

The Kent and East Sussex (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1742).

The description for this order is under the entry for Kent.

ESSEX

The Essex and Greater London (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1141) and the Essex and Greater London (County and London Borough Boundaries)(No.2) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1218).

The descriptions for these orders are under the entry for changes involving Greater London.

The Rochford (Parishes) Order 1994 (SI 1994/219)

This order creates a new parish of Rawreth. It also makes adjustments to the boundaries of four parishes. The effective date of this order is 1 April 1994.

GLOUCESTERSHIRE

The Tewkesbury (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/3134)

This order creates a new parish of Gretton from part of the parish of Winchcombe. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

GREATER LONDON

CHANGES WITHIN GREATER LONDON

The Barnet, Camden and Westminster (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1365)

This order makes small changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Barnet and Camden: It also makes one minor change to the boundary between Camden and the city of Westminster. A total of 11 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 105 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Bexley and Greenwich (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1091)

This order makes changes to the central and southern sections of the boundary between the London boroughs of Bexley and Greenwich. A total of 20 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 830. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Bromley, Croydon, Lambeth, Lewisham and Southwark (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1207)

This order makes minor changes to the boundaries of London boroughs in the South London area known as Crystal Palace. The boroughs concerned are Bromley, Croydon, Lambeth, Lewisham and Southwark. A total of 6 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 256 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Bromley and Greenwich (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 SI 1993/1225

This order makes minor alignments to the boundary between the London boroughs of Bromley and Greenwich. A total of 15 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 200. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Bromley and Lewisham (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993
SI 1993/1261**

This order makes changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Bromley and Lewisham. A total of approximately 80 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 2,240. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The City and London Borough Boundaries Order 1993 SI 1993/1445.

This order makes changes to the boundary between the City of London, the city of Westminster and the London boroughs of Camden, Hackney, Islington and Tower Hamlets. A total of approximately 61 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 1,255 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Croydon, Merton and Sutton (London Borough Boundaries)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/2350)**

This order makes minor changes in the boundary of the London borough of Merton with the London borough of Croydon and with the London borough of Sutton. A total of approximately 42 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals five people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

**The Croydon, Lambeth and Southwark (London Borough Boundaries)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/1147)**

This order makes changes within Greater London to the boundary between London boroughs of Croydon, Southwark and Lambeth. An approximate total of 11 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 850 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Ealing, Hammersmith and Fulham and Hounslow (London Borough
Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1346)**

This order makes small changes between the London boroughs of Ealing, Hounslow, as well as Hammersmith & Fulham. A total of 60 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 850 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Ealing, Hillingdon and Hounslow (London Borough Boundaries)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/1277)**

This order makes minor changes in the boundary of the London boroughs of Hillingdon, Ealing and Hounslow. A total of 36 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 390 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The East London Boroughs (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993
(SI 1993/1443).**

This order makes changes to the boundary between the London borough of Barking and Dagenham and the neighbouring boroughs of Havering, Newham and Redbridge. A new ward named Becontree ward is created in Barking & Dagenham from an area transferred from Redbridge. A total of 231 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 10,305 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The East London Boroughs (London Borough Boundaries) (No.2)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/1444).**

This order makes changes in the boundary between the London borough of Newham and the neighbouring London boroughs of Hackney, Redbridge, Tower Hamlets and Waltham Forest. A total of 89 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 1,401 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Greenwich and Lewisham (London Borough Boundaries) Order
1993 (SI 1993/1276)**

This order makes changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Greenwich and Lewisham. A total of 50 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 872 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Hackney, Haringey and Islington (London Borough Boundaries)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/1417)**

This order makes changes within Greater London to the boundary between London borough of Hackney and the London boroughs of Haringey and Islington. A total of approximately 15 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 970 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Hackney and Tower Hamlets (London Borough Boundaries) Order
1993 (SI 1993/1260)**

This order makes changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Hackney and Tower Hamlets. A total of 40 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. All areas transferred are unpopulated. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

**The Haringey and Islington (London Borough Boundaries) Order
1993 (SI 1993/1358)**

This order makes minor changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Haringey and Islington. A total of approximately two hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals two people. The effective date of the

order is 1 April 1994.

The Kensington and Chelsea and Westminster (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1262)

This order makes minor changes within Greater London to the boundary between the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea and the city of Westminster. A total of approximately seven hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 170 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Lambeth, Merton and Wandsworth (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1343)

This order makes changes in the boundary between the following London boroughs: Lambeth, Merton and Wandsworth. A total of approximately 52 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 444 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Lewisham and Southwark (London Borough Boundaries) 1993 (SI 1993/1318)

This order makes minor changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Lewisham and Southwark. A total of approximately 12 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 298 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The North and Central London (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1351)

This order makes mainly small changes within Greater London to the boundaries of the London boroughs of Brent, Ealing, Harrow, the city of Westminster and the Royal Borough of Kensington & Chelsea. The changes create a new borough ward in Ealing to be named Horsenden ward. A total of 99 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 5,961 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The North London Boroughs (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1352)

This order makes minor adjustments to the boundary between the following London boroughs: Barnet, Camden, Enfield and Haringey. A total of approximately 15 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 228 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Redbridge and Waltham Forest (London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2881)

This order makes changes to the boundary between the London boroughs of Redbridge and Waltham Forest. A total of 28 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population

affected totals 440 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

CHANGES INVOLVING GREATER LONDON

The Essex and Greater London (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1141)

This order makes slight amendments to the boundary between Greater London (London Borough of Enfield) and Essex (district of Epping Forest). It also makes minor alterations within Greater London to the boundary between the London Borough of Waltham Forest and the neighbouring boroughs of Enfield, Hackney and Haringey. The effect of almost all the changes is to realign the boundary along a river or watercourse. A total of approximately 329 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals two people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Essex and Greater London (County and London Borough Boundaries)(No.2) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1218)

This order makes mainly small changes to the boundary between Greater London and Essex, affecting the London borough of Havering, and the Essex districts of Brentwood, Epping Forest and Thurrock. It also transfers areas within Greater London between Havering and the London Borough of Barking & Dagenham. A total of 581 hectares of land has been transferred between the boroughs. The population affected totals 151 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Essex and Greater London (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2091)

This order transfers areas between greater London and Essex, affecting the boundaries of the London borough of Redbridge and of the Essex district of Epping Forest. In approximate terms 41 hectares of land has been transferred between those involved. The population affected totals 806 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1148)

This order transfers areas between the counties of Greater London and Surrey, affecting the London borough of Croydon with the Borough of Reigate and Banstead and with the district of Tandridge. Changes are also made in the boundary between the London boroughs of Bromley and Croydon. A total of 157 hectares of land has been transferred between Greater London, Surrey and Bromley. The population affected totals 1,640 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) (No.2) Order 1993 SI 1993/1208.

This order makes two boundary changes. One is to the boundary between the county of Surrey and Greater London. Parts of Stain Hill Reservoirs, are transferred to Greater London and to Richmond uniting the Reservoir and the area surrounding them in that county and borough. The other change is to the boundary between the London boroughs of Wandsworth and Richmond upon Thames. A total of 116 hectares of land has been transferred between those involved. The population affected totals six people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) (No.3) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1319).

This order makes mainly small changes in Greater London and the county of Surrey affecting the boundary of the London Borough of Sutton, the county of Surrey and the London Borough of Croydon. It also makes one small change to the boundary between Surrey and London Borough of Croydon. A total of approximately 54 hectares of land has been transferred between Greater London, Surrey and London. The population affected totals 177 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries (No.4) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1391)

This order makes mainly small changes to the boundary between Greater London and the county of Surrey and between the London boroughs of Hounslow and Richmond upon Thames. One minor change is made between Greater London and Surrey. A total of 105 hectares of land has been transferred between Greater London, Surrey, Hounslow and Richmond. The population affected totals 2,502 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1994 (SI 1994/331)

This order makes changes to the boundary between Greater London and Surrey, affecting the London boroughs of Kingston upon Thames and Sutton, and the Surrey districts of Elmbridge, Epsom and Ewell, and Mole Valley. It also makes changes within Greater London to the boundary between the London borough of Kingston upon Thames and the London boroughs of Richmond upon Thames and Sutton. A total of approximately 140 hectares of land has been transferred between those involved. The population affected totals 1,167 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

The Heathrow Airport (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1993 SI 1993/1342.

This order unites the whole of Heathrow Airport in Greater London, and in the London borough of Hillingdon by transferring areas of Buckinghamshire, Surrey and the London borough of

Hounslow. A total of 515 hectares of land has been transferred between those involved. The population affected totals seventy five people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

HEREFORD & WORCESTER

The Hereford and Worcester and West Midlands (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2971)

This order makes changes in the boundary between the county of Hereford and Worcester and the metropolitan county of West Midlands, affecting the district of Bromsgrove in Hereford and Worcester and the city of Birmingham in West Midlands. A total of approximately 206 hectares of land has been transferred between those involved. The population affected totals 8,800 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

The City of Worcester (Parishes) Order 1994 (SI 1994/557).

This order changes the boundary of the parishes of Warndon and St Peter the Great County. Eleven unparished areas have been transferred to the two parishes. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

KENT

The Kent and East Sussex (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1742)

This order transfers part of Bayham Lake from the county of East Sussex, from the district of Wealden, and from the parish of Frant to the county of Kent, to the borough of Tunbridge Wells, and to the parish of Lamberhurst. The effect of the transfer is to unite the Lake in Kent. In approximate terms, the area transferred consists of six hectares of land and is unpopulated. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1995.

LANCASHIRE

The Lancashire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1206)

This order makes small changes to the boundary of the county of Lancashire with the metropolitan county of Merseyside. A total of 45 hectares of land has been transferred between the county and the borough. The population affected totals 13 people. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The Chorley (Parishes) Order 1994 (SI 1994/67)

This order makes changes to the boundaries of the parishes of Heapey, Wheelton, Adlington, Whittle-le-Woods, Clayton-le-Woods and Anderton. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

LEICESTERSHIRE

The Harborough (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2791)

This order abolishes the parishes of Stretton Magna and Whatborough and transfers their areas to other parishes. It also makes boundary changes to seventeen other parishes. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

MERSEYSIDE

The Lancashire and Merseyside (County Boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1206)

The description for this order is under the entry for Lancashire.

NORFOLK

The Broadland (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/3242)

This order makes adjustments to the boundaries of eighteen parishes. It also creates two new wards in the parish of Taverham. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

NORTHAMPTONSHIRE

The South Northamptonshire (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2504)

This order affects parishes by transferring areas between 17 parishes and in some cases between district wards and county electoral divisions. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

NORTH YORKSHIRE

The Hambleton (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2457)

This order affects the boundary between the parishes of Coxwold and Newburgh. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE

The Bassetlaw (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2966)

This order creates a new parish of Clumber and Hardwick. It also makes several parish boundary changes. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

SOUTH OXFORDSHIRE

The South Oxfordshire (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2967)

This order creates a new parish of Waterperry with Thomley by amalgamating the two parishes of Waterperry and Thomley, which are duly abolished. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

SOUTH YORKSHIRE

The Rotherham (Parishes) Order 1994 (SI 1994/66)

This order creates a new parish of Laughton-en-le-Morthen. It also affects the boundary of an unparished areas and makes minor adjustments to the boundaries of four parishes. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

STAFFORDSHIRE

The Stafford (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2466)

This order affects the boundary between the parish of Hopton and Coton and surrounding unparished areas. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

SUFFOLK

The Babergh (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2792)

This order abolishes the parishes of Copdock and Washbrook. It also creates two new parishes: Copdock and Washbrook, and Pinewood. It also makes minor adjustments to several parish boundaries. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

The St Edmundsbury (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2454)

This order affects the boundary between the parishes of Chevington and Chedburgh. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

SURREY

The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) Order 1994 (SI 1994/331):The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough boundaries) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1148):The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) (No.2) Order 1993 SI 1993/1208:
The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries) (No.3) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1319) and The Greater London and Surrey (County and London Borough Boundaries (No.4) Order 1993 (SI 1993/1391)

The descriptions for these orders are under the entry for changes involving Greater London.

TYNE AND WEAR

The Durham and Tyne and Wear (County and District Boundaries)
(Variations) Order 1993/3129.

The description for this order is under the entry for Durham.

WARWICKSHIRE

The Rugby (Parishes) Order 1993 (SI 1993/2790)

This order transfers areas between ten parishes. It also affects the boundary between some parishes and an unparished area. The effective date of the order is 1 April 1994.

WEST MIDLANDS

The Hereford and Worcester and West Midlands (County Boundaries)
Order 1993 (SI 1993/2971)

The description of this order is under the entry for Hereford and Worcester.
