PROPOSALS FOR THE FUTURE ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR  
THE DISTRICT OF DERWENTSIDE IN THE COUNTY OF DURHAM

1. We, the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, having carried out our review of the electoral arrangements for the district of Derwentside in accordance with the requirements of section 63 of, and Schedule 9 to, the Local Government Act 1972, present our proposals for the future electoral arrangements of that district.
  
2. In accordance with the procedure prescribed in section 60(1) and (2) of the 1972 Act, notice was given on 31 December 1974 that we were to undertake this review. This was incorporated in a consultation letter addressed to the Derwentside District Council, copies of which were circulated to the Parish Councils in the district, the Durham County Council, the Members of Parliament for the constituencies concerned and the headquarters of the main political parties. Copies were also sent to the editors of the local newspapers circulating in the area and of the local government press. Notices inserted in the local press announced the start of the review and invited comments from members of the public and from any interested bodies.
  
3. The Derwentside District Council were invited to prepare a draft scheme of representation for our consideration. When doing so, they were asked to observe the rules laid down in Schedule 11 to the Local Government Act 1972 and the guidelines which we set out in our Report No 6 about the proposed size of the council and the proposed number of councillors for each ward. They were also asked to take into account any views expressed to them following their consultation with local interests. We therefore asked that they should publish details of their provisional proposals about a month

before they submitted their draft scheme to us, thus allowing an opportunity for local comment.

4. The Council have passed a resolution under section 7(4)(a) of the Local Government Act 1972 requesting a system of whole council elections.

5. On 27 May 1975, the Derwentside District Council presented their draft scheme of representation. The Council proposed to divide the area of the district into 23 wards, each returning 1, 2 or 3 members, to form a council of 55.

6. We considered the draft scheme submitted by the Council. We noted that, in general, the scheme complied with the rules in Schedule 11 to the Local Government Act 1972 and our own guidelines.

7. We accepted a suggestion that the name of the proposed ward comprising the parishes of Cornsay, Hedleyhope and Satley should be changed from "Satley to "Cornsay". We adopted some minor amendments to ward boundaries suggested by Ordnance Survey to align them to detail. We formulated our draft proposals accordingly.

8. On 3 October 1975 we issued our draft proposals and these were sent to all who had received our consultation letter or had commented on the Council's draft scheme. The Council were asked to make those draft proposals, and the accompanying maps which defined the proposed ward boundaries, available for inspection at their main offices. Representations on our draft proposals were invited from those to whom they were circulated and, by public notices, from members of the public and interested bodies. We asked that any comments should reach us by 28 November 1975.

9. There was general support for our draft proposals but comments were received relating to the proposed Havannah and Stanley Hall wards. It was said that the boundary between these two wards broke local ties between residents on both sides of the A693 road who formed part of the East Stanley community. Proposals were put forward for creating an additional ward in this area and, alternatively, for realigning the boundary between the proposed Havannah and Stanley Hall wards. We examined these proposals but concluded that it would not be possible to find a more satisfactory boundary than the A693 road and that the wards proposed in our draft proposals gave better representation than the alternative proposals. We therefore decided to confirm our draft proposals for these wards, and formulated our final proposals accordingly.

10. We, therefore, confirm our draft proposals as our final proposals.

11. Details of these final proposals are set out in Schedule 1 to this report and on the attached maps. Schedule 1 gives the names of the wards and the number of councillors to be returned by each ward. The boundaries of the new wards are defined on the maps.

#### PUBLICATION

12. In accordance with section 60(5)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972, a copy of this report and a copy of the maps are being sent to Derwentside District Council and will be made available for public inspection at the Council's main offices. Copies of the report (without maps) are also being sent to those who received the consultation letter and those who made comments. A detailed

description of the boundaries of the proposed wards as defined on the maps is set out in Schedule 2 to this report.

Commencing at a point on the northern boundary of the district at NG reference NZ 0964954448 thence northwards and following said boundary to Pont Burn, thence southwestwards and following said Burn to Pont Lane, thence northwestwards along said Lane to a point opposite the northwestern boundary of parcel No 3853 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 12-1352 edn of 1963 thence southwestwards and following said boundary and the northwestern boundary of parcel No 1941 on said Plan to Dere Street, thence southeastwards along said Street to the prolongation northeastwards of the western boundary of the property known as Fan House, thence southwestwards along said prolongation and boundary to the southernmost corner of said property, thence southwestwards in a straight line to the dismantled railway at NG reference NZ 1192551681, thence northwestwards along said railway to a point opposite the northernmost corner of parcel No 5880 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 10-1151 edn of 1968, thence westwards in a straight line to said corner, thence southwestwards along the western boundary of said parcel to the northern boundary of parcel No 4400 on said Plan and Plan NZ 10-1152 edn of 1963 thence northwestwards along said boundary and the northern boundary of parcel No 3100 on said Plan to the northern boundary of parcel No 2200 on said Plan, thence northwards and northwestwards along said boundary and the northern boundary of parcel No 0700 on said Plan to Medomsley Road thence northwestwards in a straight line across said Road to the southern boundary of parcel No 9929 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 10-1152 edn of 1963 thence northwestwards along said boundary to the westernmost corner of said parcel, thence continuing northwestwards in a straight line to the easternmost corner of parcel No 5431 on said Plan, thence northwestwards and following the northern boundary of said parcel and the northern boundary of parcel No 3747 and in prolongation thereof to the dismantled railway known as Derwent Walk, thence northeastwards and following said dismantled railway to Whinny Lane, thence northwestwards, along said

#### DIPTON WARD

Commencing at the point where the northeastern boundary of Dipton Ward meets the eastern boundary of Ebchester and Medomsley Ward, thence northwards and following said eastern boundary to the northern boundary of the district, thence southeastwards and following said boundary to a point at NG reference NZ 1883857107, thence due south from said point to the northern boundary of parcel No 8500 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 18-1957 edn of 1961 thence southwestwards along said boundary and the northern boundary of parcel No 7400 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 18-1956 edn of 1961 to the eastern boundary of parcel No 6800 on said plan, thence southeastwards along said boundary to the path from the property known as Crookbank to Barcusclose Lane, thence southeastwards and following said path to said Lane thence southeastwards along said Lane to the northwestern boundary of parcel No 5900 on the aforementioned Plan thence southwestwards along said boundary to the eastern boundary of parcel No 3700 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 18-1955 edn of 1960 thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of parcel No 4479 on said Plan, thence

southwestwards along said boundary to the eastern boundary of parcel No 2079 on said Plan, thence northwestwards and southwestwards along the eastern and northern boundaries of said parcel to the northern boundary of parcel No 0069 on said Plan and on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 16-1755 edn of 1961 thence westwards along said boundary to the southeastern boundary of parcel No 8270 on the last named Plan, thence southwestwards along said boundary and the southern boundary of parcel No 7075 on said Plan to the eastern boundary of the property known as Townhead, thence southwards and following the eastern, southern and western boundaries of said property to the track from said property to the A6077 road thence southwestwards and following said track to and across said road to the western boundary of No 15 Clough Dene thence southwestwards along said boundary and the eastern boundaries of parcels No 2614, 2113 and 1900 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 16-1755 edn of 1961, thence continuing southwestwards along the eastern boundaries of parcels No 1900 and 1890 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 16-1754 edn of 1970 to the southernmost corner of the last named parcel, thence southwestwards in a straight line to the path from the rear of Corvan Terrace to the Plough Inn (PH), thence northwestwards and following said path and in prolongation thereof to the A692 road, thence southwestwards along said road to the A6067 road, thence southwestwards along said road to the northern boundary of Dipton Ward, thence northwestwards and following said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### TANFIELD WARD

Commencing at the point where Bushblades Lane meets the eastern boundary of Dipton Ward, thence northeastwards along said boundary to the eastern boundary of Burnopfield Ward thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of the district, thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the road to the north of Beamish Burn, thence westwards and following said road to the Foot Bridge across Beamish Burn as shown on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 20-2155 edn of 1960, thence southeastwards along

said Foot Bridge to the centre of said Burn, thence southwestwards and following said Burn to Beamishburn Road, thence southwestwards and following said Road to Causey Road thence northwestwards across said Road to the unnamed road being parcel No 0316 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 20-2154 edn of 1960 and parcel No 7040 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 18-1954 edn of 1971, thence northwestwards along said road to Houghwell Burn, thence southwestwards and following said Burn and Kyo Burn to Kyo Lane, thence northwestwards along said Lane to Bushblades Lane, thence northwestwards along said Lane to the point of commencement.

#### BENFIELDSIDE WARD

Commencing at NG reference NZ 0901652443 on the western boundary of the district, thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the western boundary of Ebchester and Medomsley Ward, thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the dismantled railway, thence southwestwards and following said railway to the A691 road, thence northwestwards and following said road to a point opposite the northern boundary of No 1 Cutlers Hall Road, thence northwestwards in a straight line to the point of commencement.

#### BLACKHILL WARD

Commencing at a point on the western boundary of the district opposite the point where Howden Burn meets the River Derwent, thence northwards and following said boundary to the southern boundary of Benfieldside Ward, thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the southern boundary of Ebchester and Medomsley Ward thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the eastern boundary of Consett & District Golf Course, thence southwestwards along said boundary to the northern boundary of the property known as The Bungalow, thence northwestwards along said boundary, the northern boundary of the property known as Westdale and the northern boundary

of Elmfield Road to the eastern boundary of the property known as The Ferns, thence northeastwards, northwestwards and southwestwards along the eastern, northern and western boundaries of said property to the eastern boundary of Consett Grammar School Playing Field thence southwestwards and following said boundary and the eastern boundary of Consett Grammar School to Durham Road thence southwestwards along said Road to the fence to the east of the eastern boundary of the property known as Blackfyne House, thence southwestwards along said boundary to the northern boundary of the property known as Blackfyne thence eastwards, southwards and westwards along the northern, eastern and southern boundaries of said property to the rear boundary of No 34 Clarence Gardens, thence southwards and westwards following the rear boundaries of Nos 34 to 25 Clarence Gardens, and in prolongation thereof to the western boundary of the Recreation Ground to the south of said Gardens, thence southwestwards along said boundary to the northern boundary of Consett Park, thence southeastwards in a straight line across said Park to a point on Park Road opposite the northwestern boundary of No 53 Park Road, thence northwestwards along said Road to the eastern boundary of No 60 Park Road, thence southwards along said boundary to the northern boundary of Consett Iron Works, thence westwards and following said boundary to the western boundary of said Works, thence southwards along said boundary to a point opposite the northern boundary of parcel No 6512 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 08-0951 edn of 1963, thence due west to said boundary, thence northwestwards along said boundary to the southern boundary of Mortimer Street, thence southwestwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of the aforementioned parcel, thence northwestwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of parcel No 1408 on said Plan, thence westwards along said boundary to Pemberton Road, thence southwards and following said Road to NG reference NZ 0914950933 thence northwestwards in a straight line to Howden Burn, thence southwestwards, northwestwards and following said Burn to the River Derwent, thence due west across said River to the point of commencement.

#### DELVES LANE WARD

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of Healeyfield CP meets the southern boundary of Crookhall Ward, thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of Caribbees Plantation thence southeastwards and southwestwards along the northern and eastern boundaries of said Plantation to the northern boundary of parcel No 258 on OS 1:2500 County Series Durham Sheet XI 15 edn of 1921, thence southeastwards along said boundary to the unnamed road, thence southeastwards across said road to the northern boundary of Castledene House, thence southeastwards along said boundary and the northern boundary of parcel No 2245 on



OS 1:2500 County Series Durham Sheet XVIII.3 edn of 1921 to the northern boundary of Lanchester CP, thence southwestwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of Healeyfield CP, thence northwestwards and following said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### LEADGATE WARD

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of Delves Lane Ward meets the eastern boundary of Crookhall Ward thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the northeastern boundary of Consett North Ward, thence northwestwards and following said boundary to the southern boundary of Ebchester and Medomsley Ward thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the western boundary of Dipton Ward, thence southwards and following said boundary to Pontop Pike Lane, thence southwestwards to Stoneyheap Lane, thence continuing southwestwards along said Lane to Hangingstone Lane, thence eastwards along said Lane to the western boundary of Greencroft CP, thence southwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of Lanchester CP, thence northwestwards and continuing northwestwards along the eastern and northern boundary of Delves Lane Ward and following said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### ANNFIELD PLAIN WARD

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of Greencroft CP meets the eastern boundary of Leadgate Ward, thence northwards and following said Ward boundary to the A693 road, thence southeastwards along said road to Blackett Street, thence northeastwards and following said Street to North Road, thence southeastwards along said Road to a point opposite the southeastern boundary of Catchgate Methodist Church, thence northeastwards to and along said boundary to the northeastern boundary of said Church, thence northeastwards in a straight line to Ryde Terrace, thence northeastwards along said boundary to the path from No 1 Ryde Terrace to West Kyo Mission Hall, thence northeastwards along said path to the unnamed road to the south of said Mission Hall, thence southeastwards along said road to the path

from the end of said road to the railway, thence southeastwards along said path and continuing southeastwards across said railway to its southeastern boundary, thence southwestwards and following said boundary to the southwestern boundary of parcel No 2976 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 16-1751 edn of 1970, thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the southwestern boundary of parcel No 3669 on said plan thence southeastwards and northeastwards along the southwestern and southeastern boundaries of said parcel to the southwestern boundary of Langley Terrace, thence southeastwards along said boundary and continuing southeastwards to and along the southwestern boundary of Croft Terrace to the southernmost corner of No 1 Croft Terrace, thence southwestwards in a straight line to the unnamed road between the Electricity Sub-Station and Prospect Terrace, thence southeastwards along said road to Shieldrow Lane, thence southwestwards along said Lane to the A6076 road, thence southwards and following said road to the northern boundary of Lanchester CP, thence westwards, southwards and following said boundary to the northern boundary of Greencroft CP, thence northwestwards and following said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### CATCHGATE WARD

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of Annfield Plain Ward meets the eastern boundary of Dipton Ward, thence northeastwards and following said eastern boundary to the southern boundary of Tanfield Ward, thence southeastwards along said boundary to Kyo Burn, thence southwestwards along said Burn to the western boundary of parcel No 5884 on OS 1:2500 Plan NZ 16-1752 edn of 1961 thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the stream between said parcel and parcel No 7348 on said Plan, thence southeastwards along said stream to the western boundary of the last named parcel, thence southwards and following said boundary to the northwestern boundary of parcel No 6729 on said Plan thence southwestwards and southeastwards along the northwestern and southwestern boundaries of said parcel to the railway, thence

Commencing at the point where the northern boundary of South Moor Ward meets the eastern boundary of Catchgate Ward, thence northwestwards and following said eastern boundary to the southern boundary of Tanfield Ward, thence northeastwards and following said boundary to the eastern boundary of the district thence southeastwards and following said boundary to the A693 road at the Red Robin Inn (PH) thence northwestwards and following said road along its new alignment to the northern boundary of South Moor Ward, thence southwestwards and following said boundary to the point of commencement.

#### SOUTH STANLEY WARD

Commencing at the point where the path from Stanley Burn to Hustledown Road meets the northern boundary of South Moor Ward, thence westwards and following said boundary to the southern boundary of Havannah Ward, thence northeastwards along said boundary to Wear Road, thence southeastwards along said
