Sanderstead is a very ancient area and as such should be respected in any ward boundary changes. Sanderstead encompasses Essenden Road to Mayfield Road including houses backing on the railway. Then St Mary's Road, Beech Avenue and the perimeter of the Purley Downs Golf course. Then up Rectory Park and Mitchley Hill and the roads to the right and then right onto the Limsfield both the village but also the residential area adjacent to Sanderstead Railway station. The boundary should be on the eastern side Addington Road then Upper Selsdon Road to the corner of West Hill, then down road encompassing all roads to the left and right until the Croydon Borough border at Hamsey Green. This line would preserve the essential character of what residents perceive to be Sanderstead, and also covers the area of the Sanderstead Residents Association a strong voice in the local community
