Dear Sirs

Hartpury Parish Council discussed the Boundary Review at its meeting last night and would like to submit the following:

Hartpury Parish Council would like to re-iterate their previous submission in support of the Ward being set as originally proposed with Hartpury, Upleadon and Corse combining with Rudford and Highleadon to form one ward. The Parish Council feel that this will protect and strengthen existing links between Parishes.

The Parish Council have strong reservations and concerns regarding the size of the now proposed ward which is to consist of 8 Parishes, the Parish Council do not feel that this is supportive of effective and convenient local government.

The Parish Council feel strongly that the Community would be better served with a single District Councillor who can be held accountable when necessary.

We would also point out that, as far as the County Council is concerned, currently Bromsberrow, Redmarley, Pauntley and Staunton are in Newent Division and Corse, Hartpury, Highleadon and Rudford are in Mitcheldean Division. Hence the proposed new Ward is split between two County Council Divisions, which again seems to militate against effective and convenient local government.

Hartpury Parish Council are aware that Corse and Staunton Parish Councils have met and submitted a proposal that Corse, Staunton and Hartpury form one ward. Hartpury Parish Council do not see any benefit in this proposal and it is felt that this would break existing ties and shared services between Hartpury and Upleadon.
