I wish to fully support the Draft Recommendations as put forward by the Commission. I note in particular, that the Commission has taken on board the comments I made concerning the naming of Wards that comprise my County Council electoral division. As the County Councillor for Nuthall which includes Watnall and Strelley I am keen that subsequent names for component parts should be simple and meaningful and consequently the Commission's proposals to have the logical names of Nuthall East and Strelley for one half and Nuthall West and Watnall for the other half makes complete sense.

It is my understanding that Broxtowe Borough Council are going to urge you to reconsider the naming of Nuthall West and Watnall to include the name Greasley. This is a nonsense. There is no historical connection with the name of Greasley throughout the 1000 years of Watnall history. Indeed other names such Chaworth and Cantelupe have been associated with the land holdings in the village but these names have long since fallen into disrepute. To reiterate my earlier comments nobody in the Watnall area uses the name Greasley at any time and would have no reason to because Watnall is an actual place, Greasley is not.

I trust therefore, that you will stick to the simplified names that you have proposed in your Draft Recommendations.
